Legislative Advocacy



- Build relationships
 - Invite candidates to meet
 - Share superintendent cell phone number with elected officials
 - Respond to requests to testify
 - Keep elected officials informed of current topics and issues
- Invite legislators to schools



Legislative Advisory Council (LAC) Overview



- Administrative Regulation 801.2 Legislative Advisory Council
- Purpose
 - Enhance community understanding of legislative proposals that impact education and the district; promote citizen involvement in the process
- Role
 - Provide administration and School Board input on legislative priorities and the impact of proposed legislation; a nonpartisan council
- Membership
 - 7 citizens (staggered 2-year terms); 9 reps from other district advisory councils (annual); 5 high school students (annual); 3 School Board members (ex-officio); Superintendent and Communications staff

LAC Activities



- Regular meetings 6 of them, 6-7:30 p.m., September-May
- District 196 Legislative Forum Before session begins, at a district school
- Testify on bills During session, whenever needed, as requested, usually staff
- District 196 Day at the Capitol About one month after session begins
- Post-session meeting with legislators late May

District 196 Day At the Capitol



- Scheduled 15-minute meetings
 - Most of the work happens before the day
- Start in Governor's reception area as one group
- Divide into two groups
- Be flexible and ready to walk
- Elevator speech on priorities; let parents and students share as much as possible
- Make a personal connection with each legislator to strengthen relationships
- Have an ask, offer to help, stay in touch
