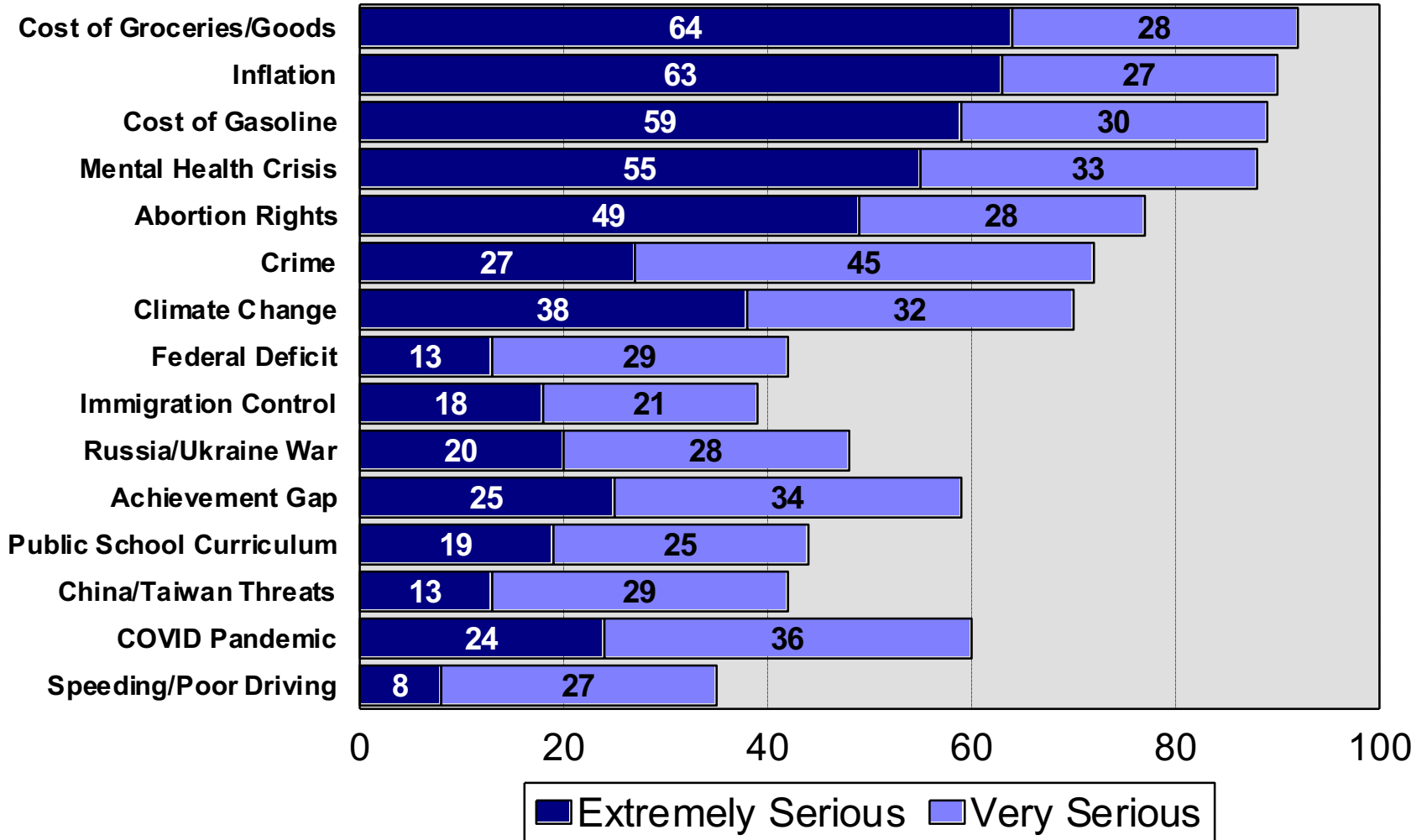

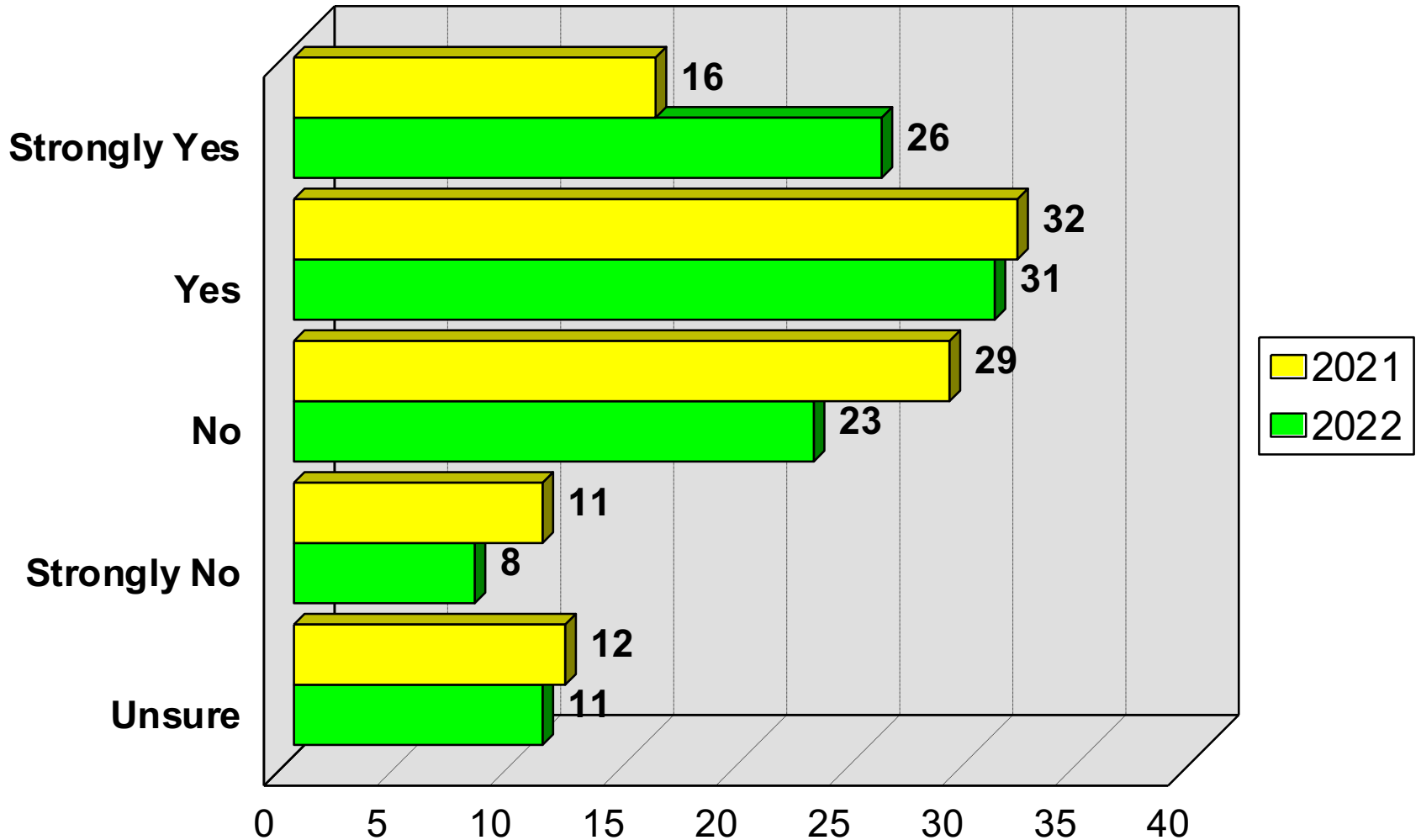

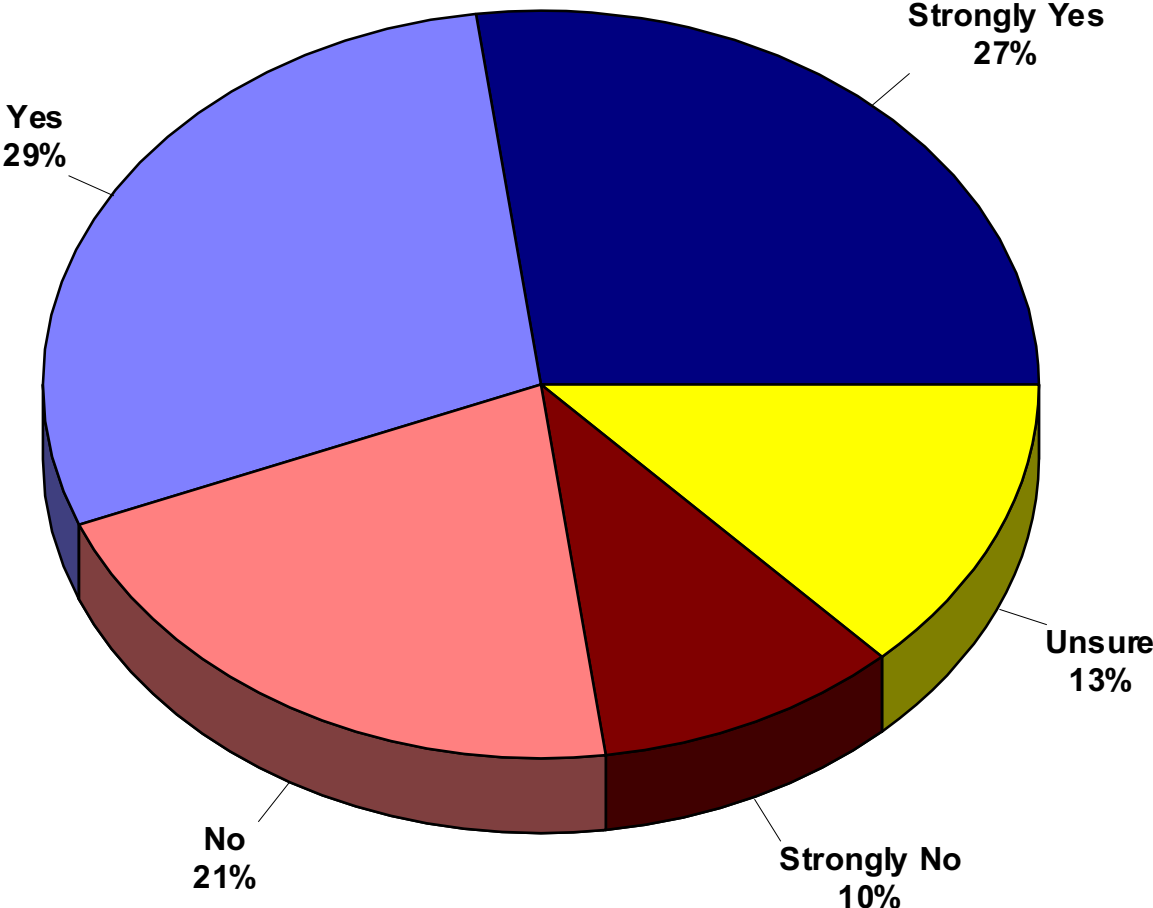

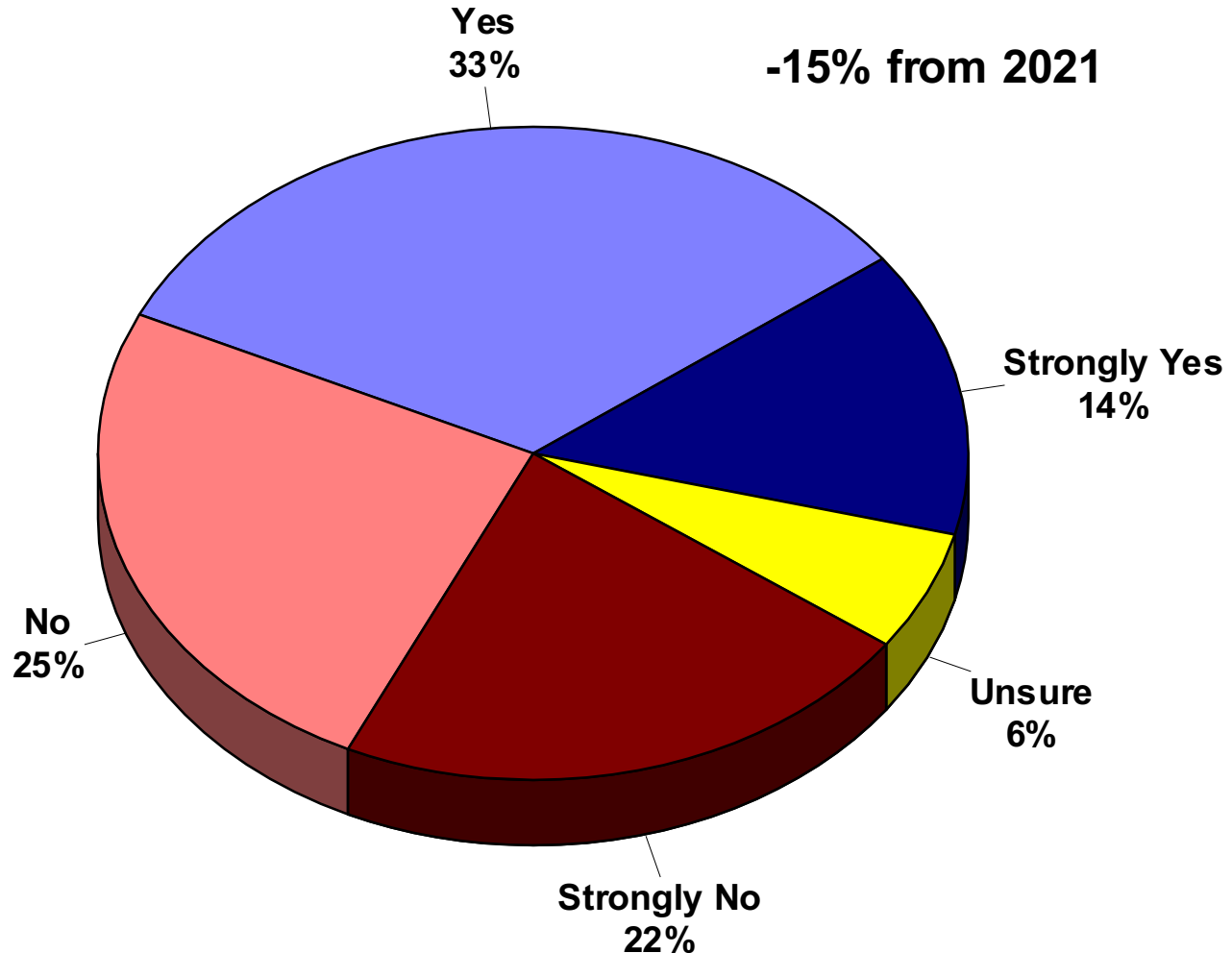

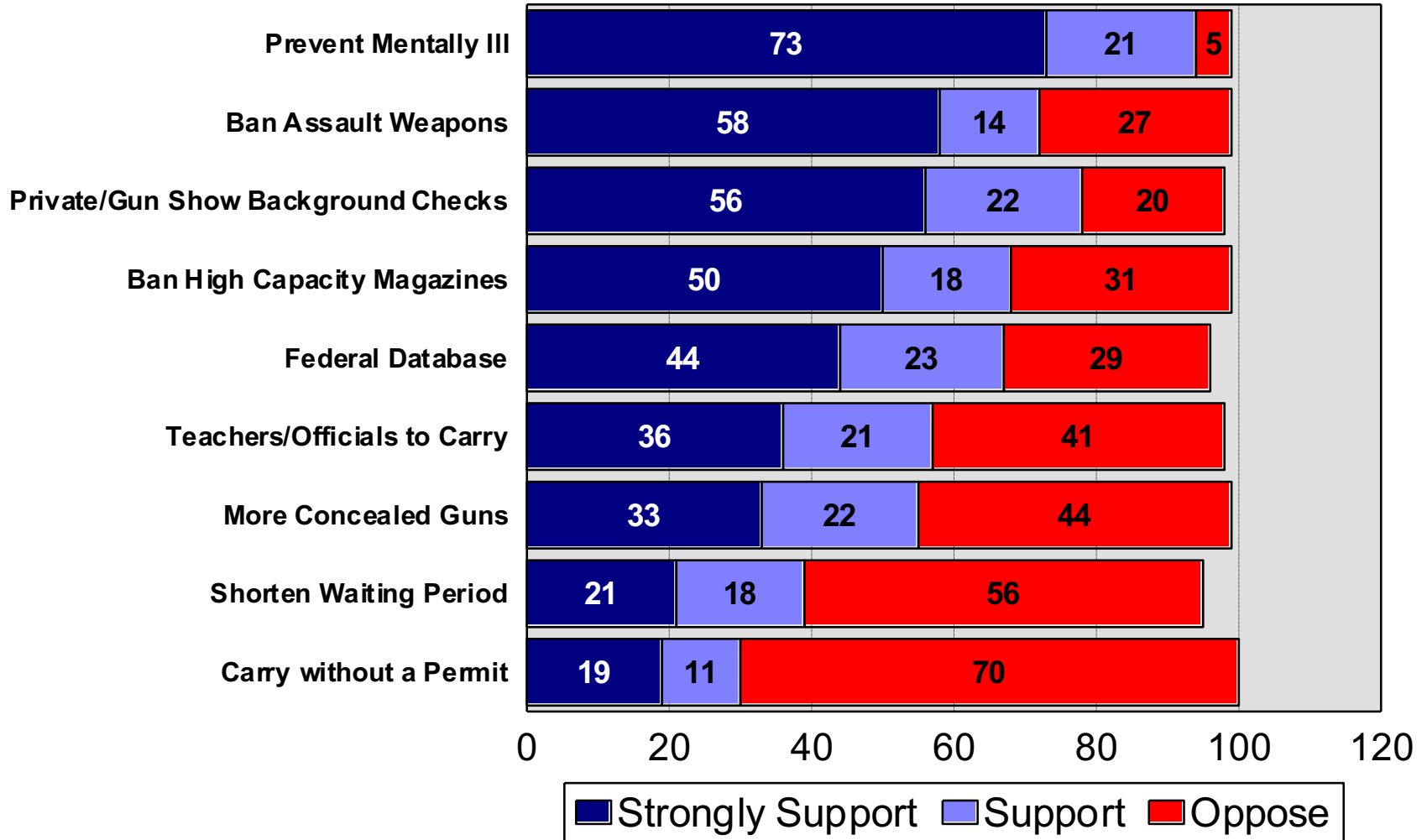

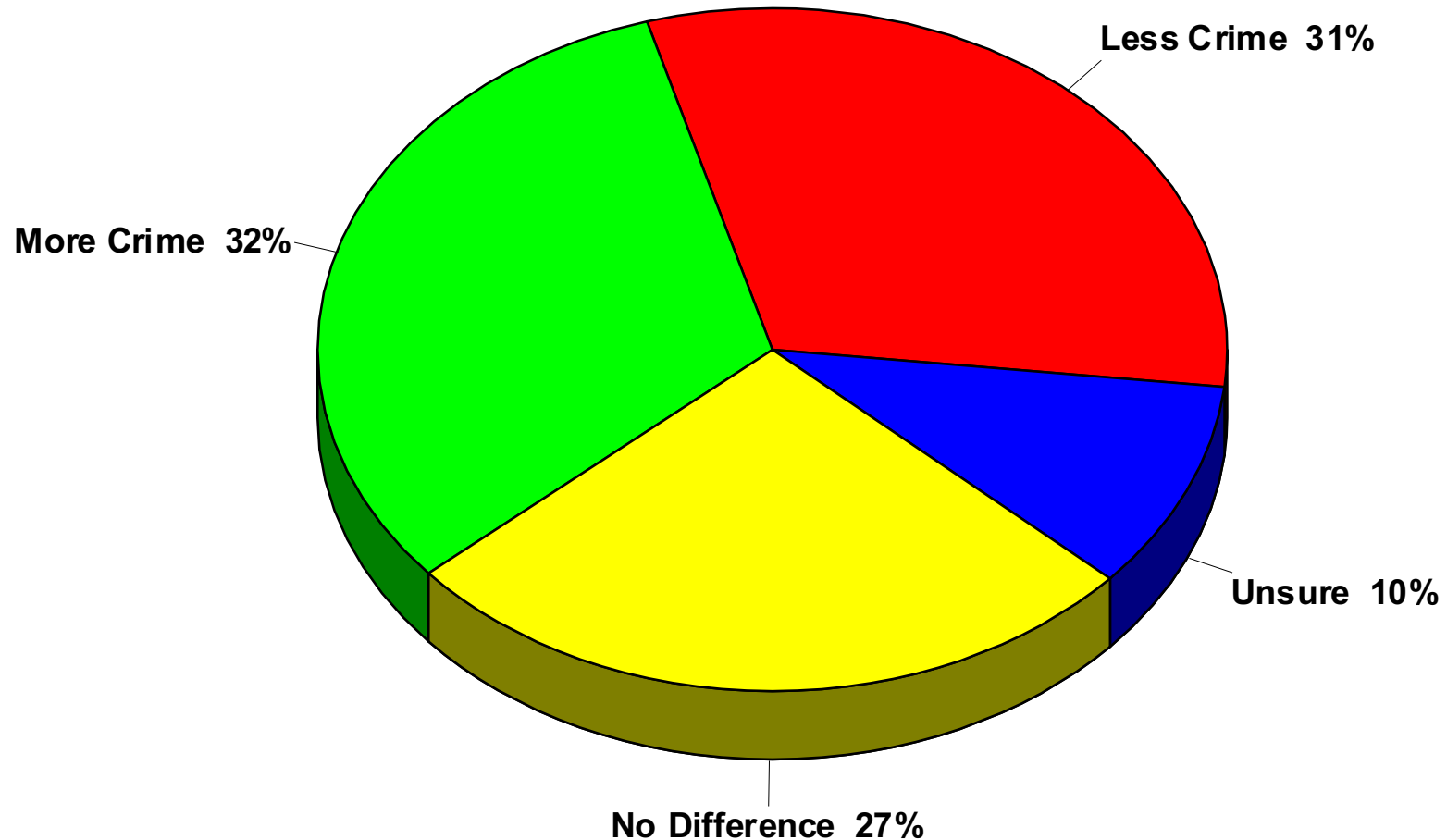

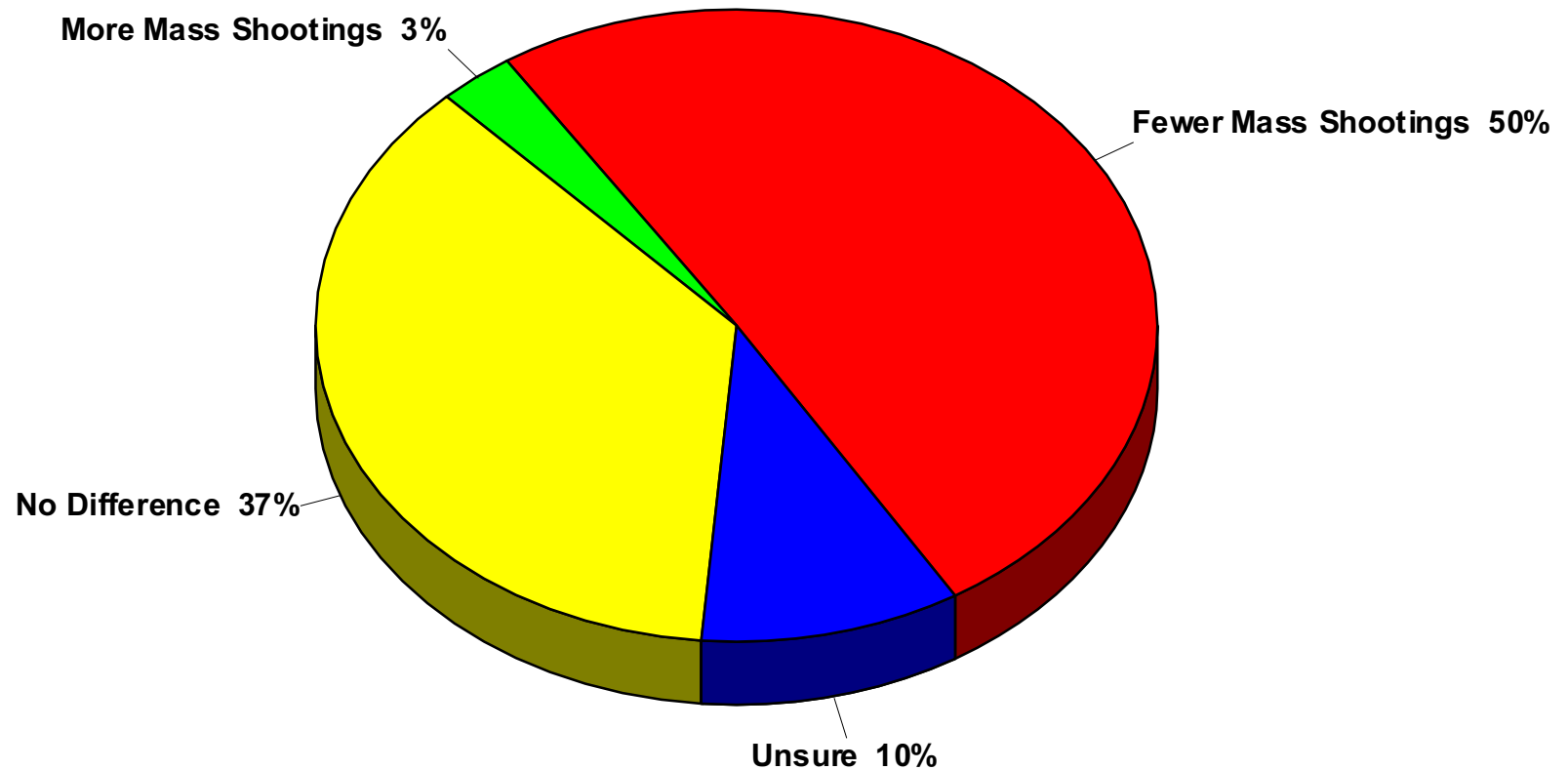

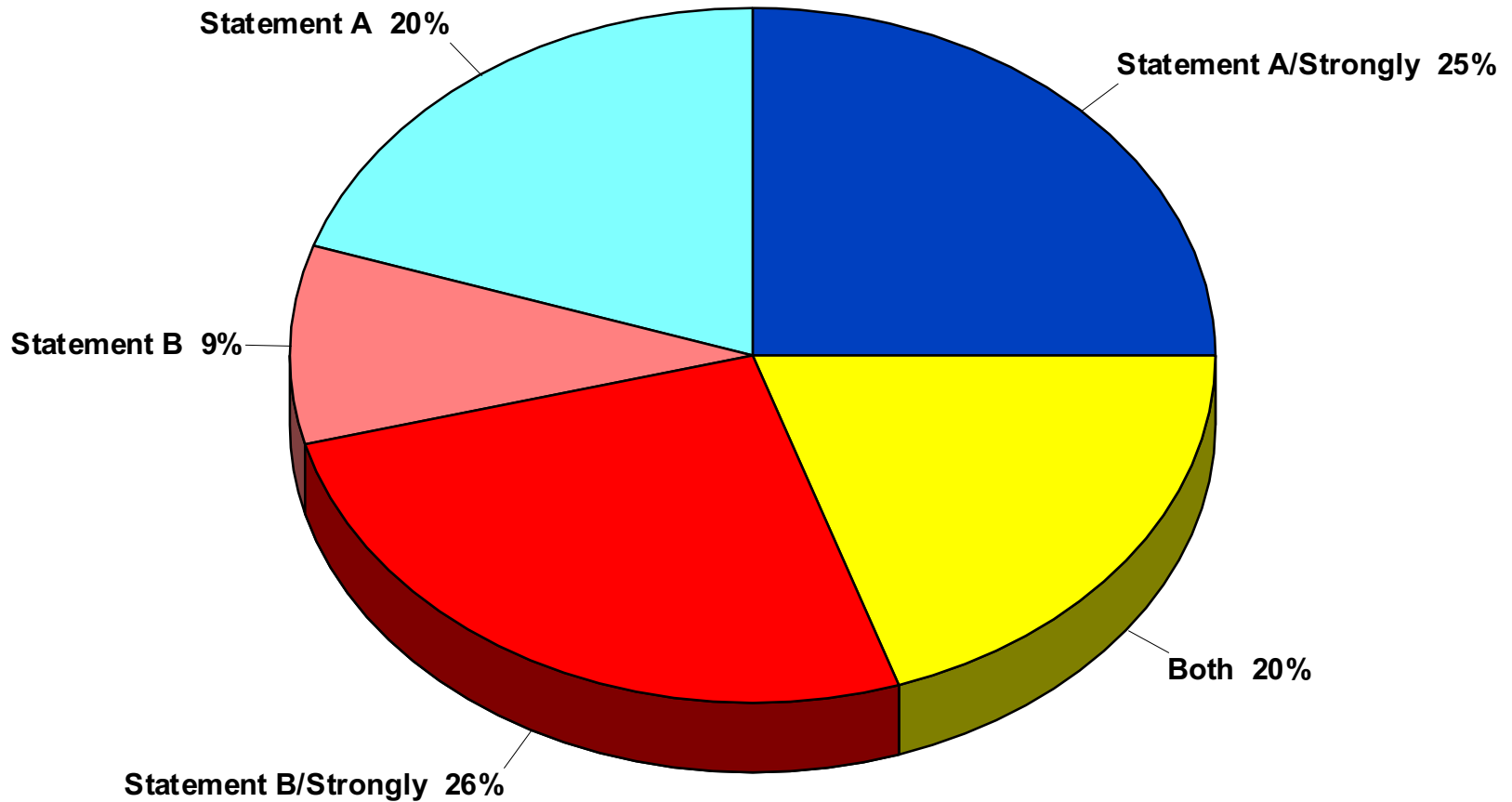

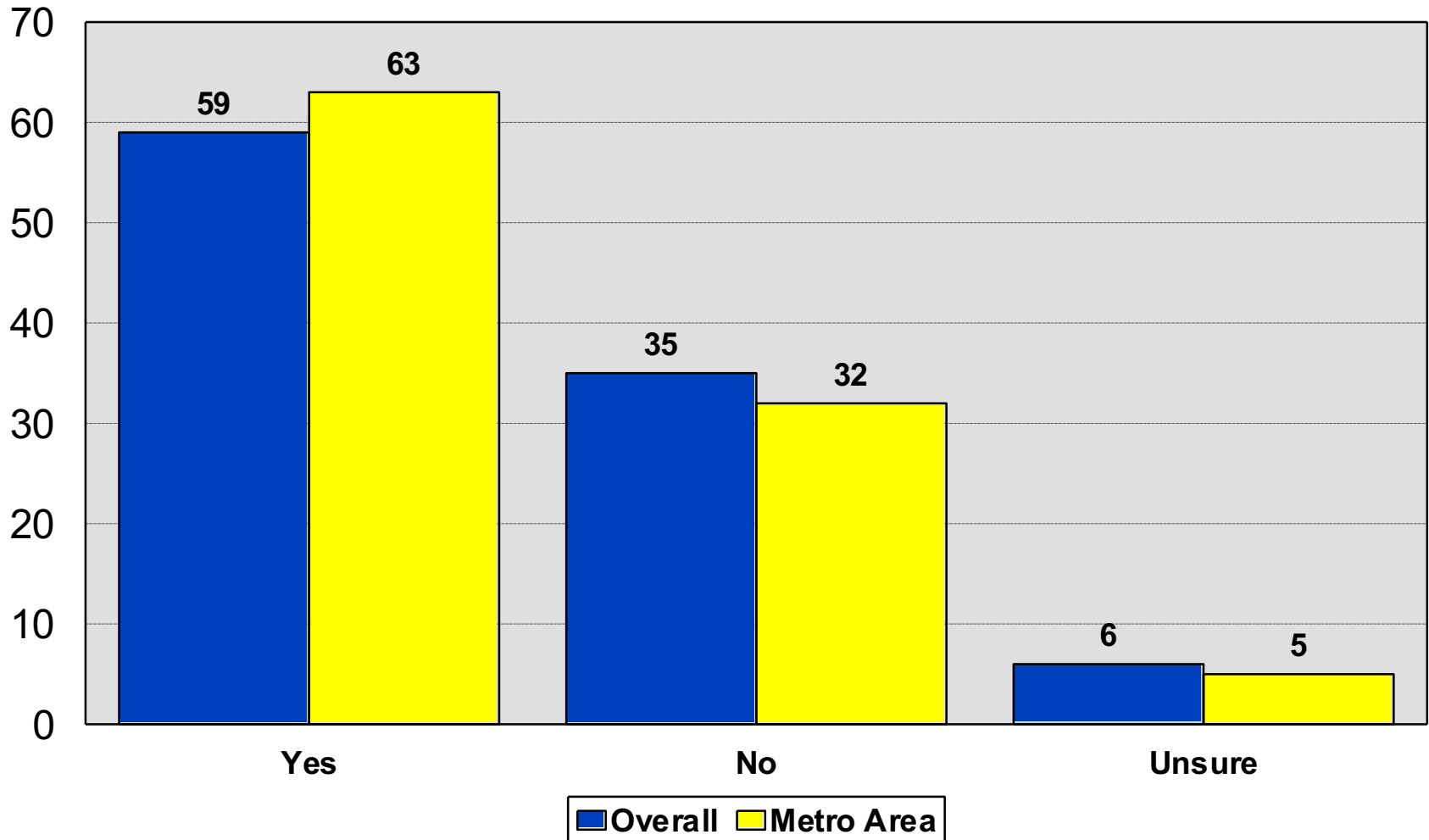

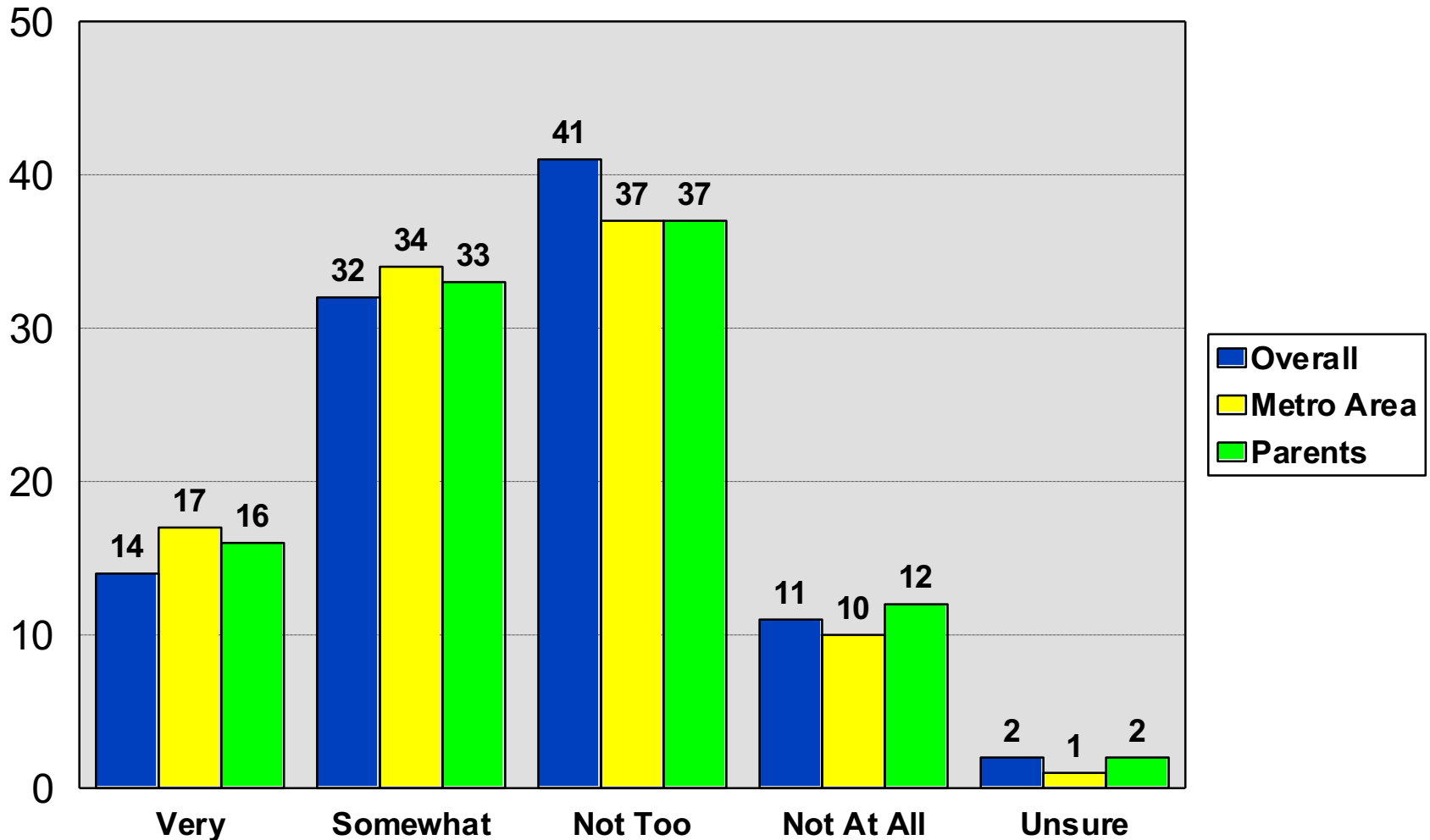

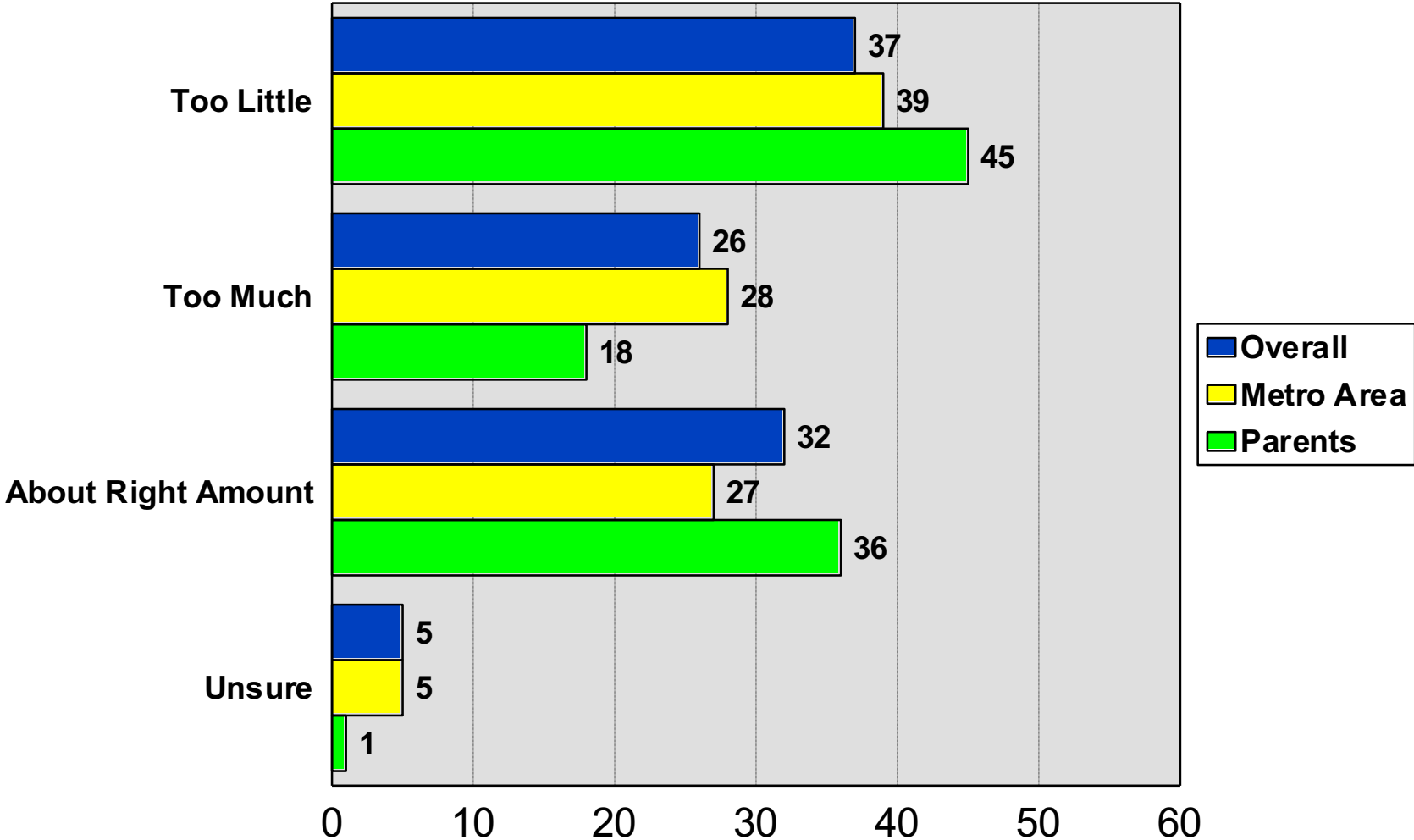

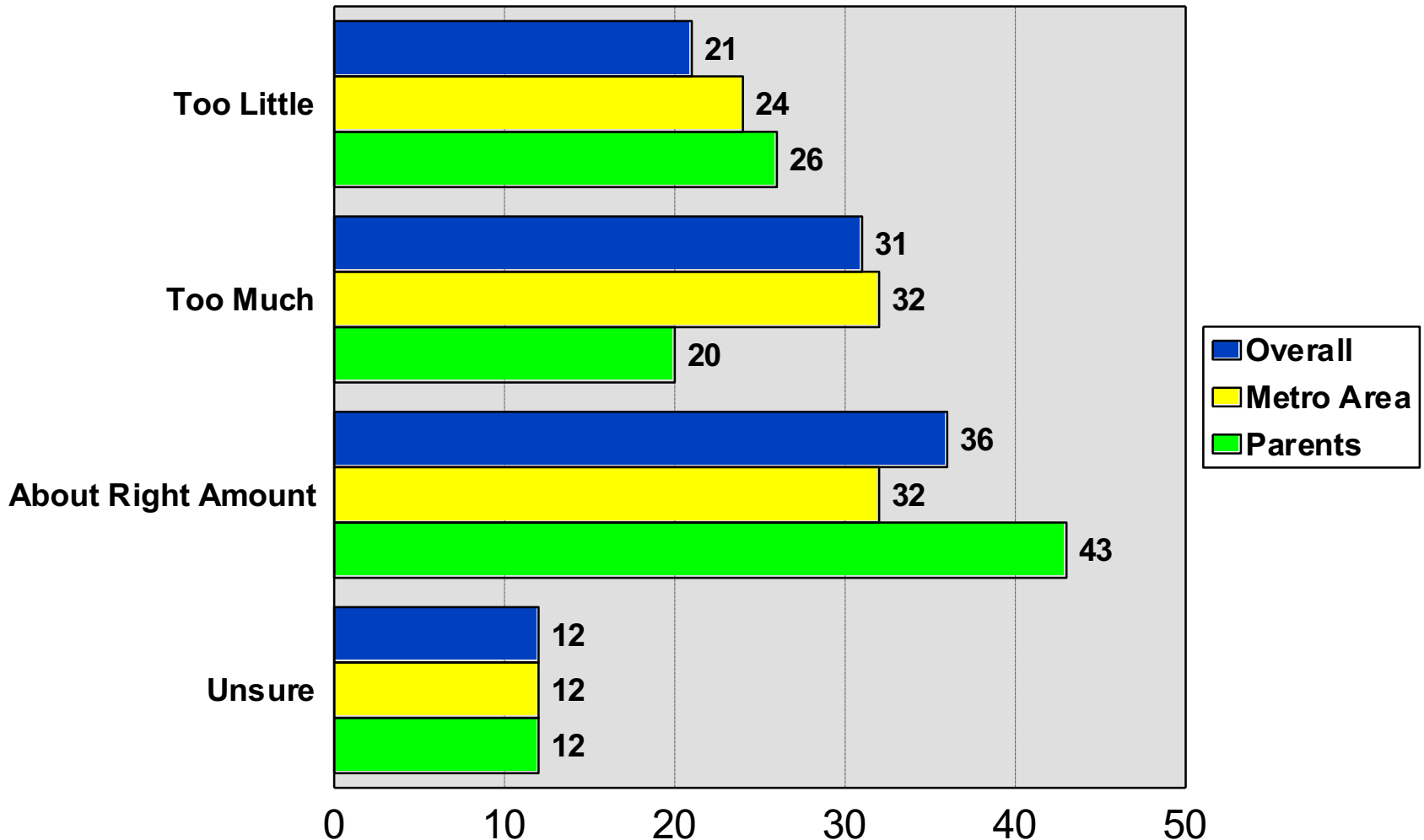

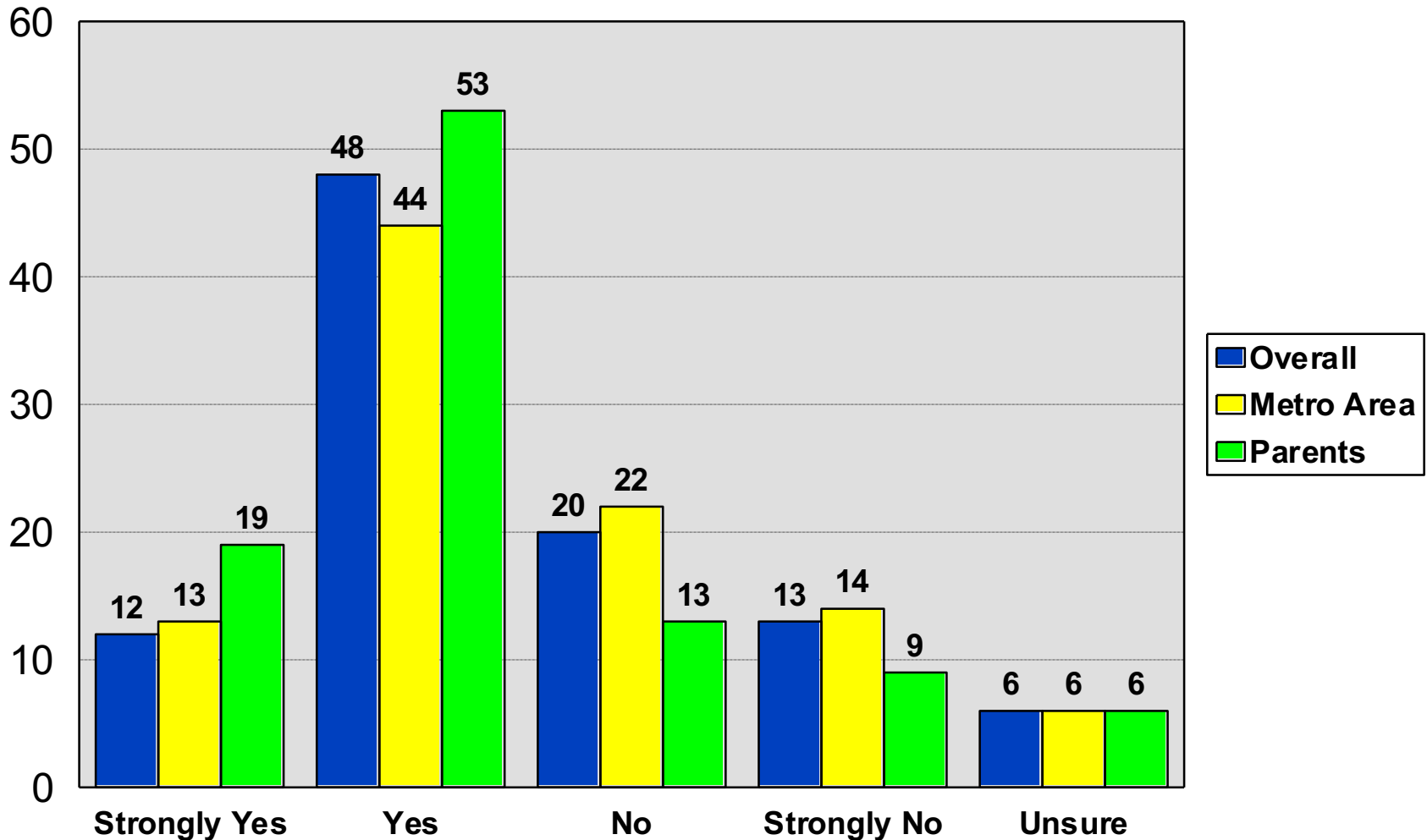

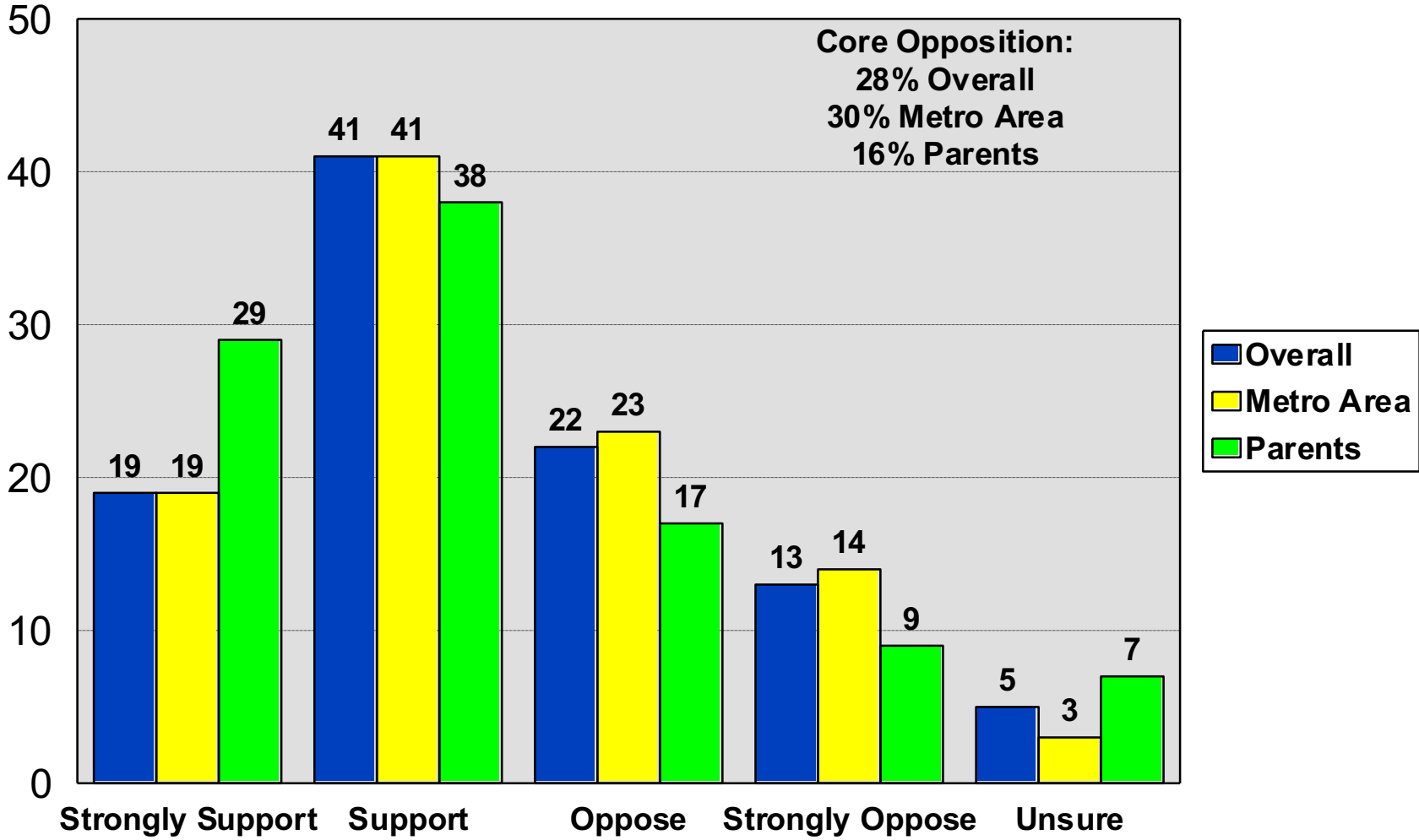

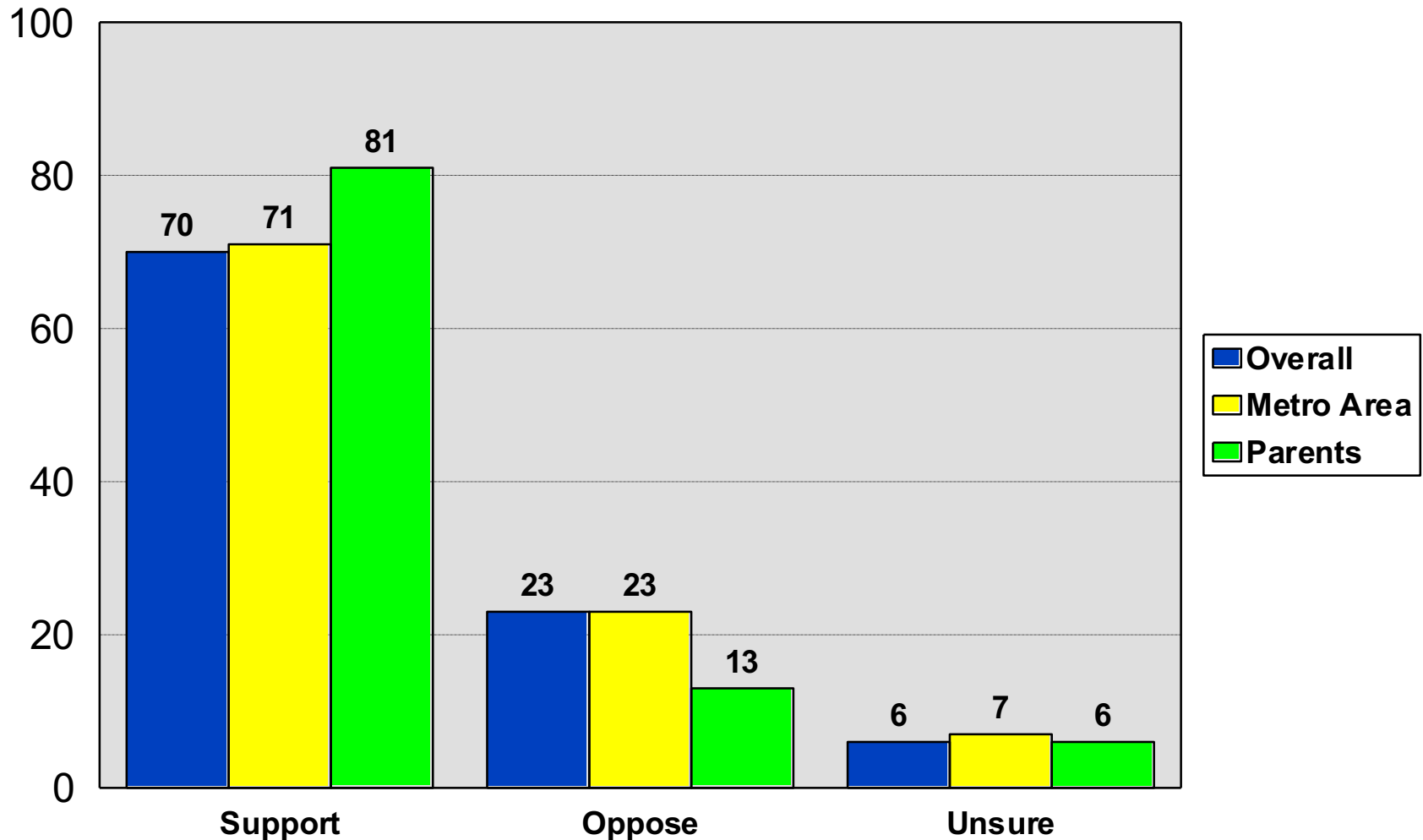

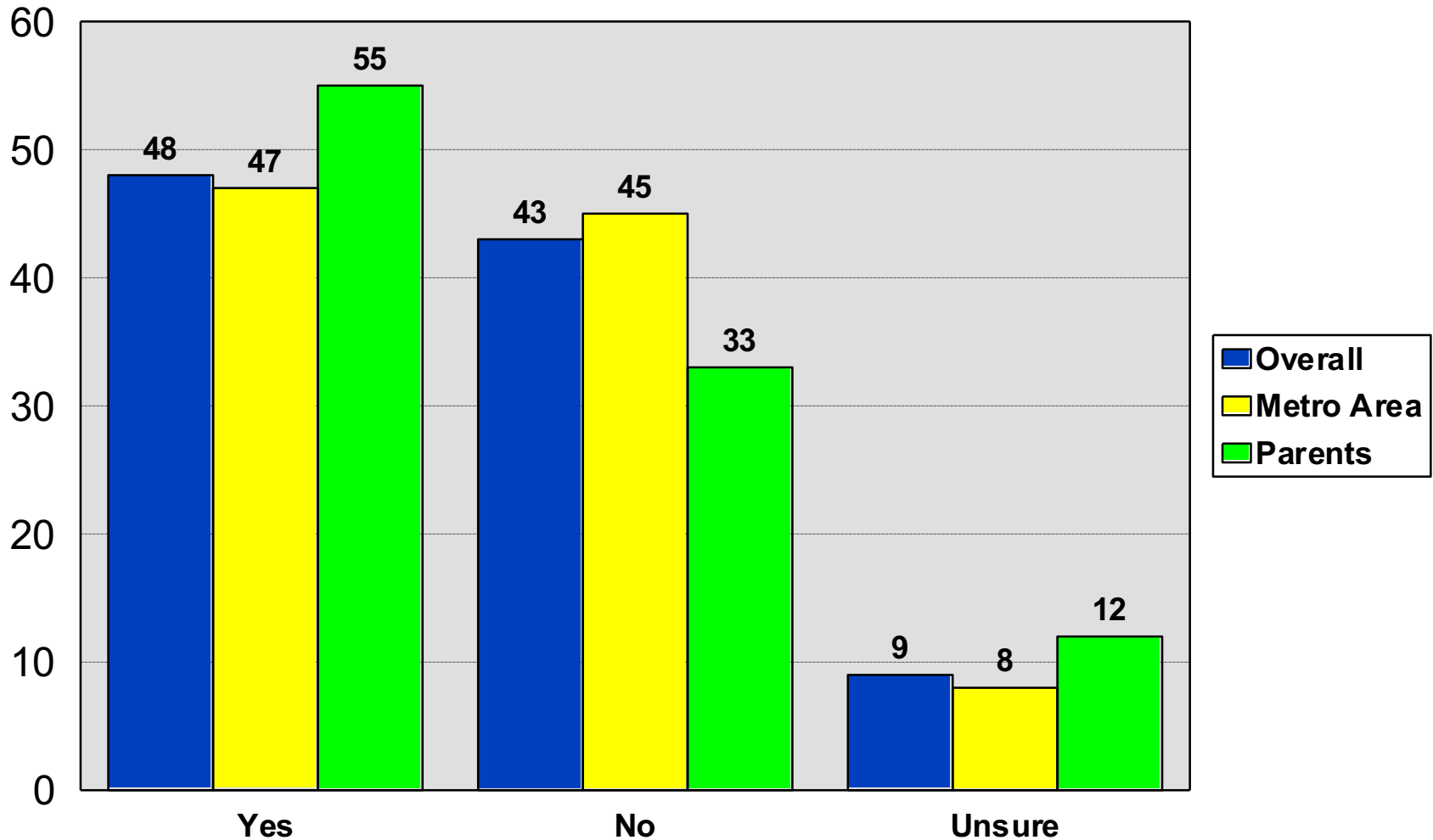

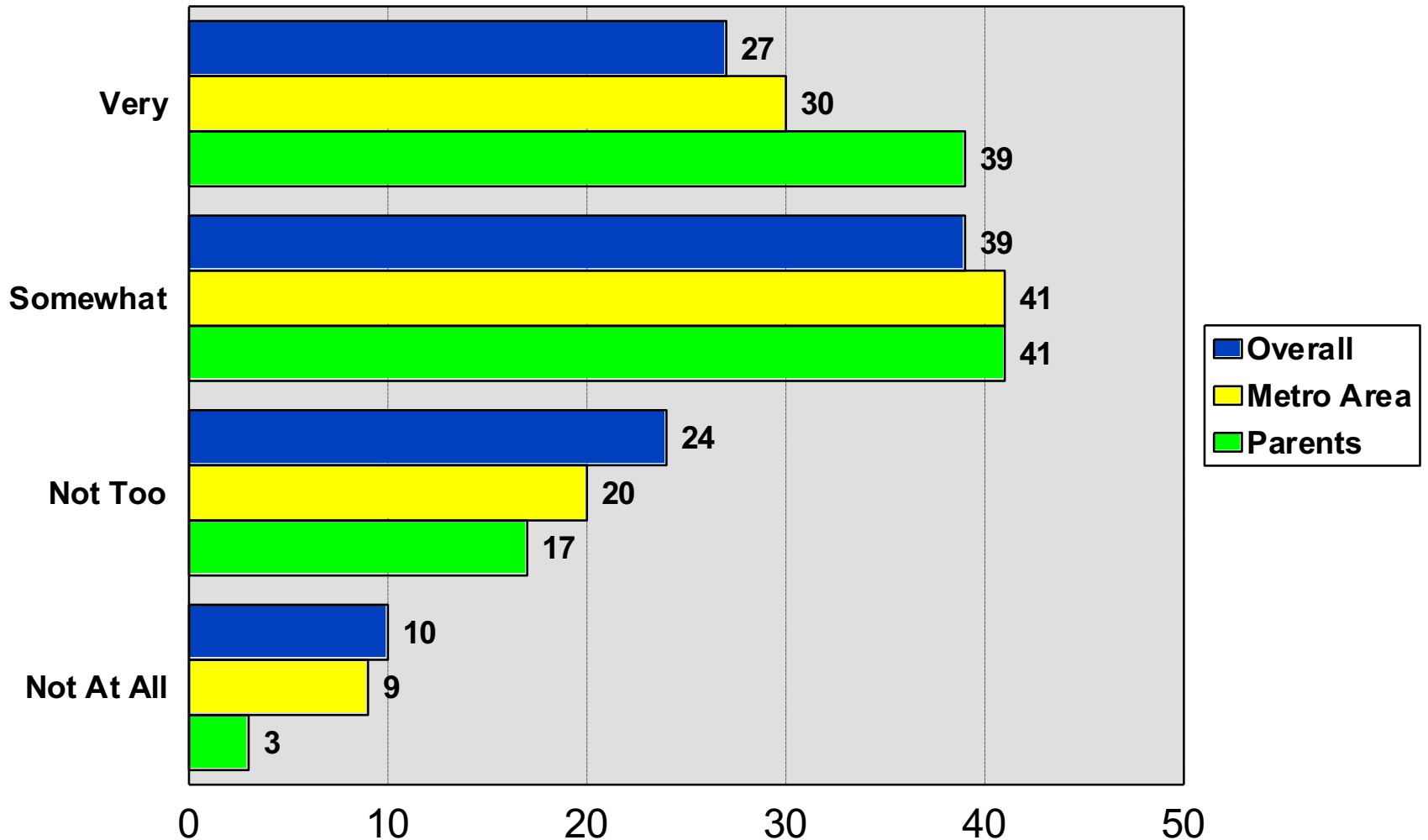

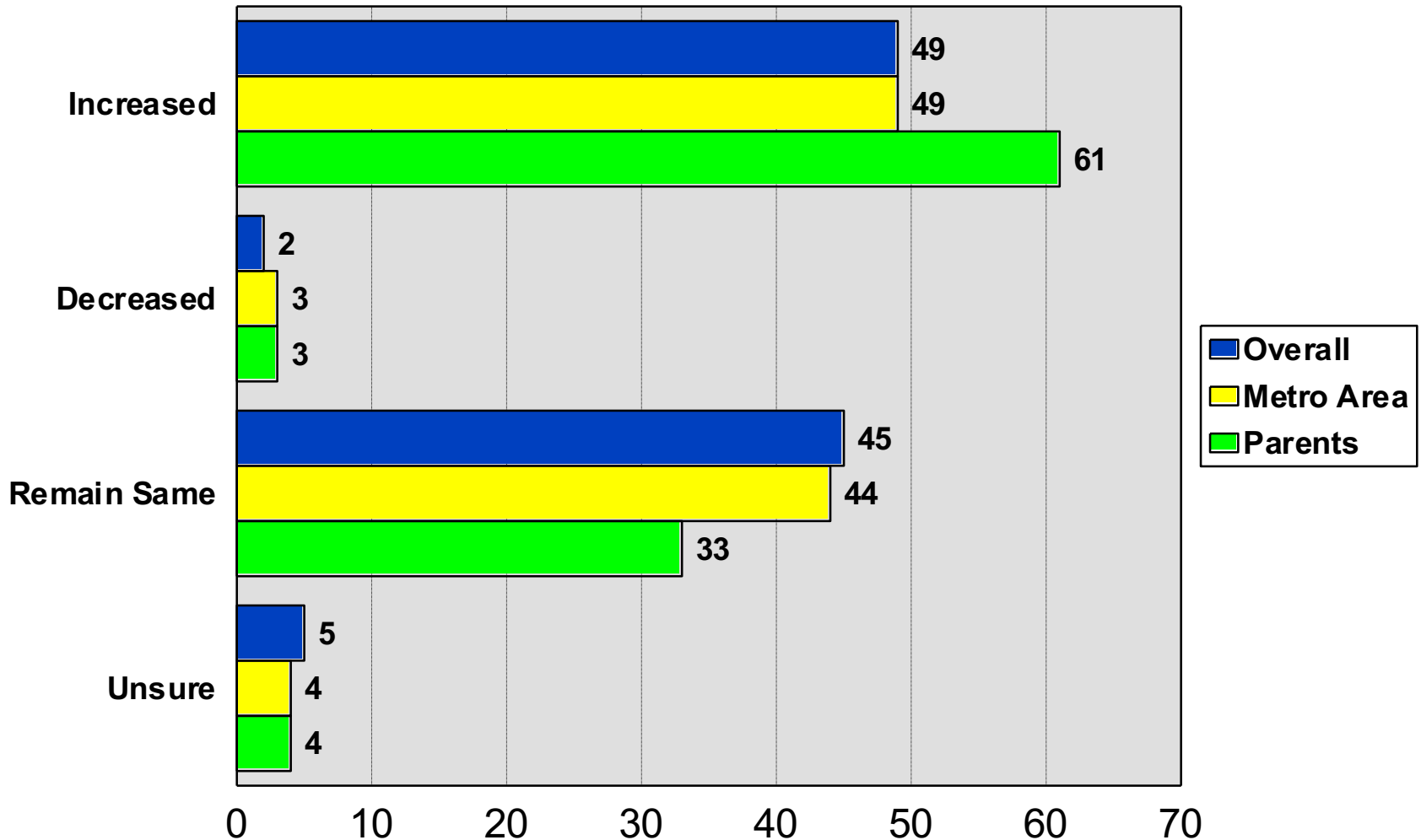

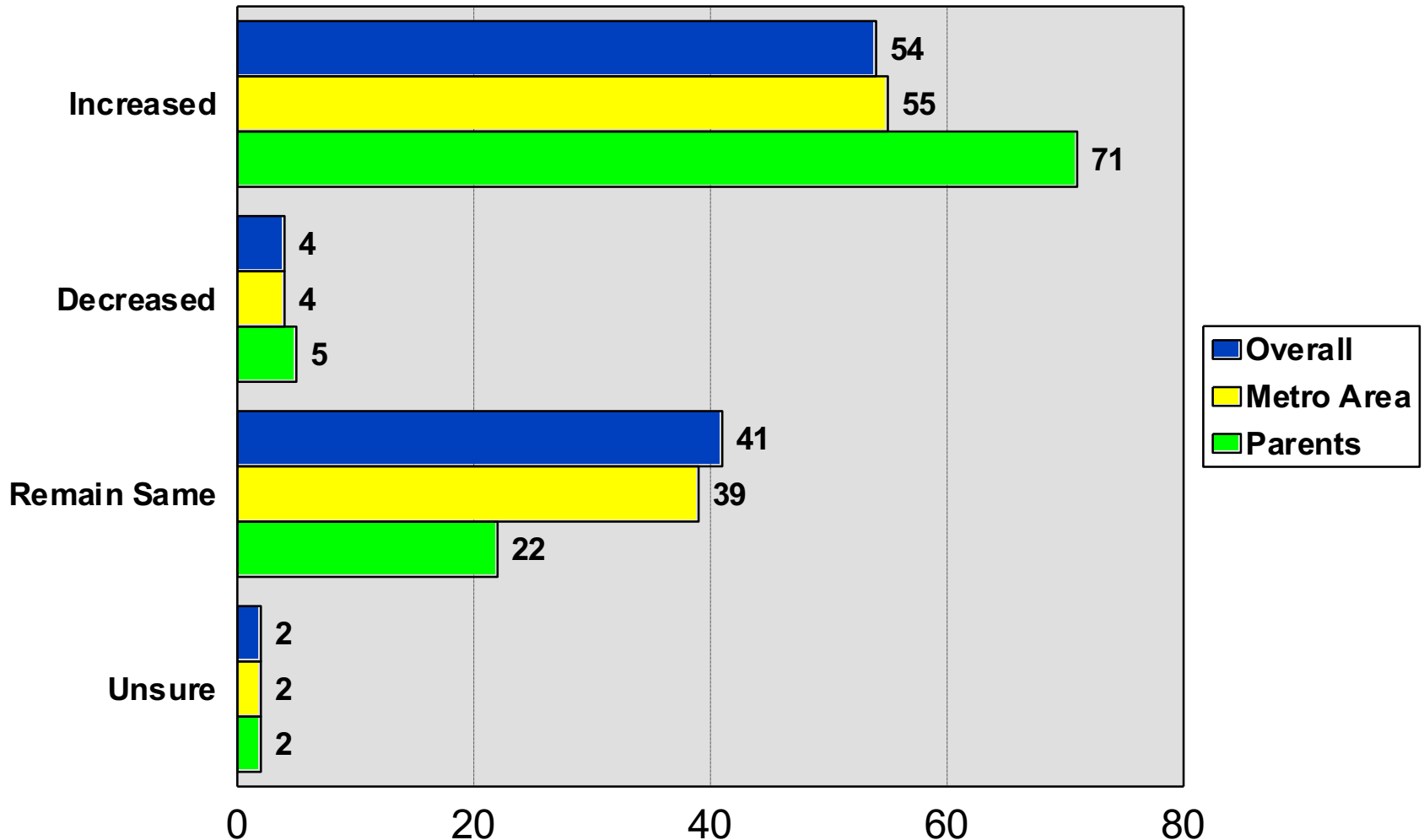
Should Teachers' Salaries be Increased (Generic)

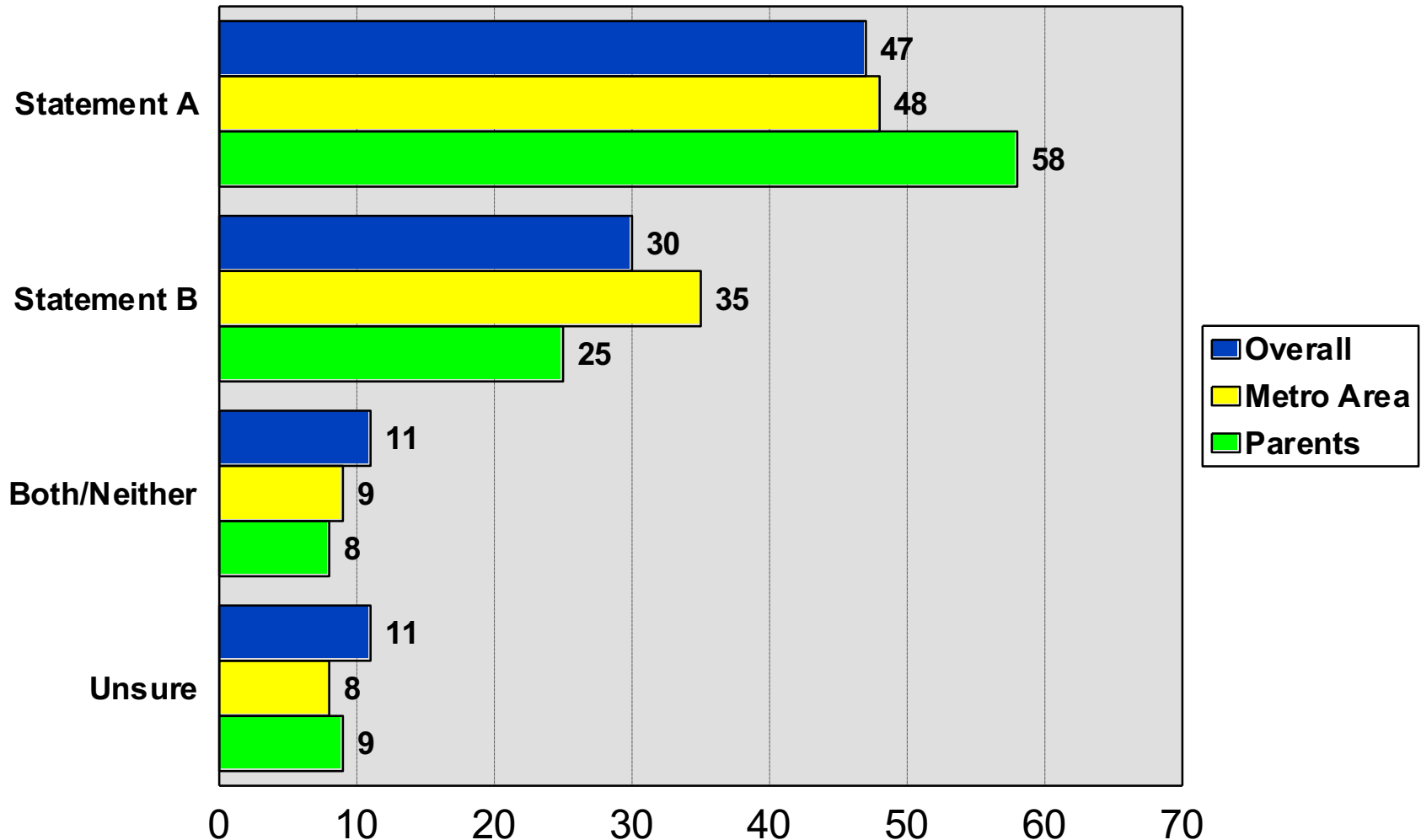

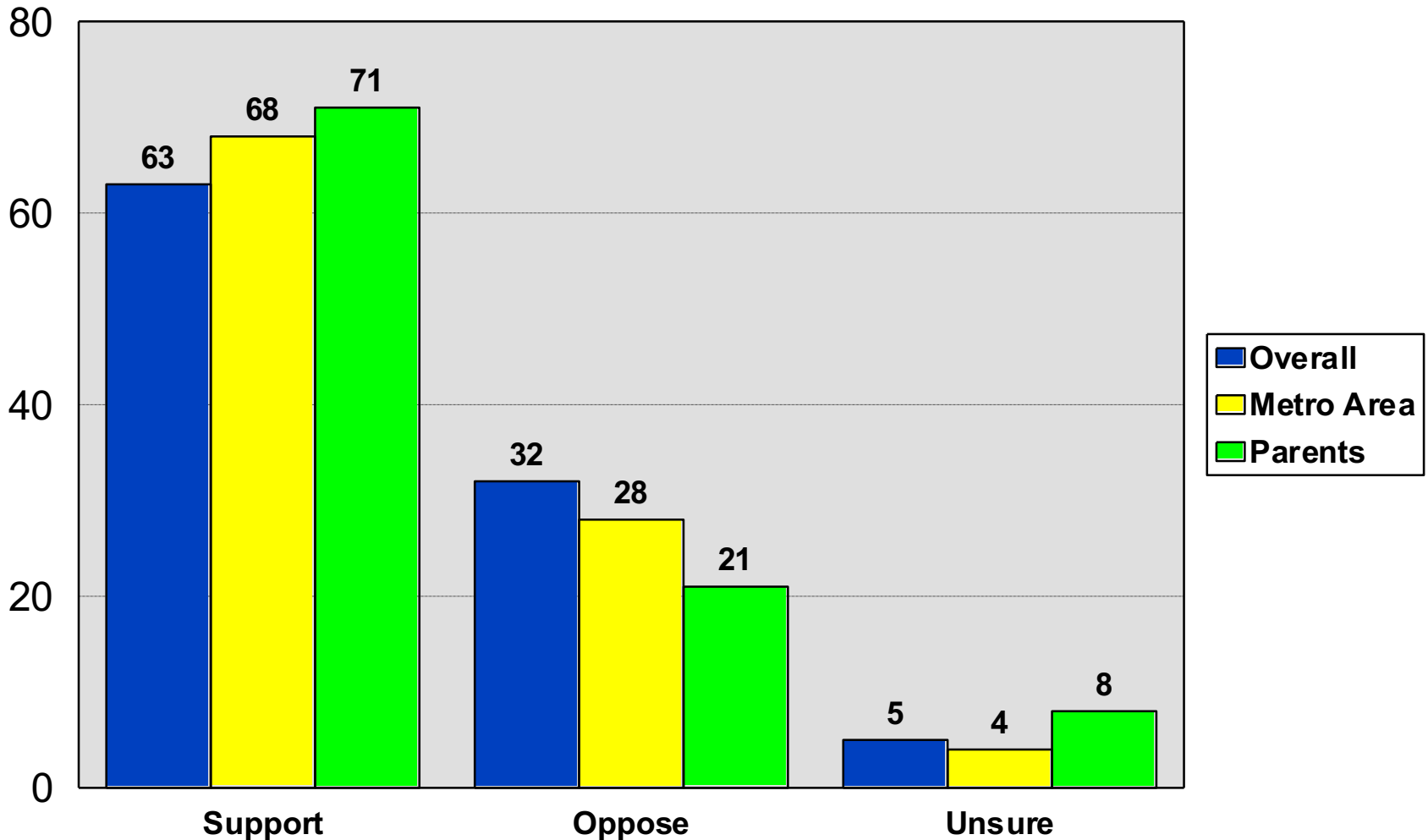

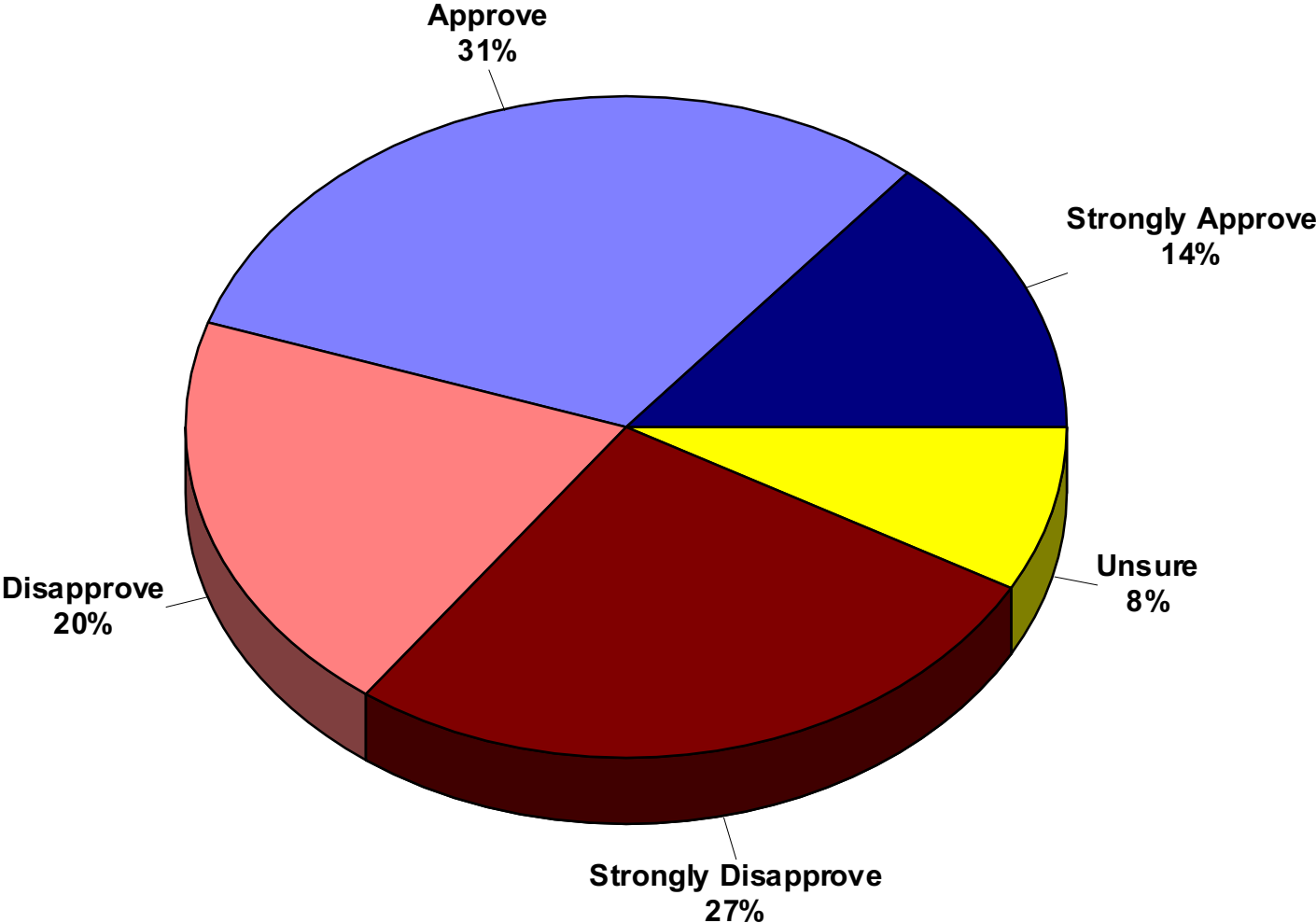

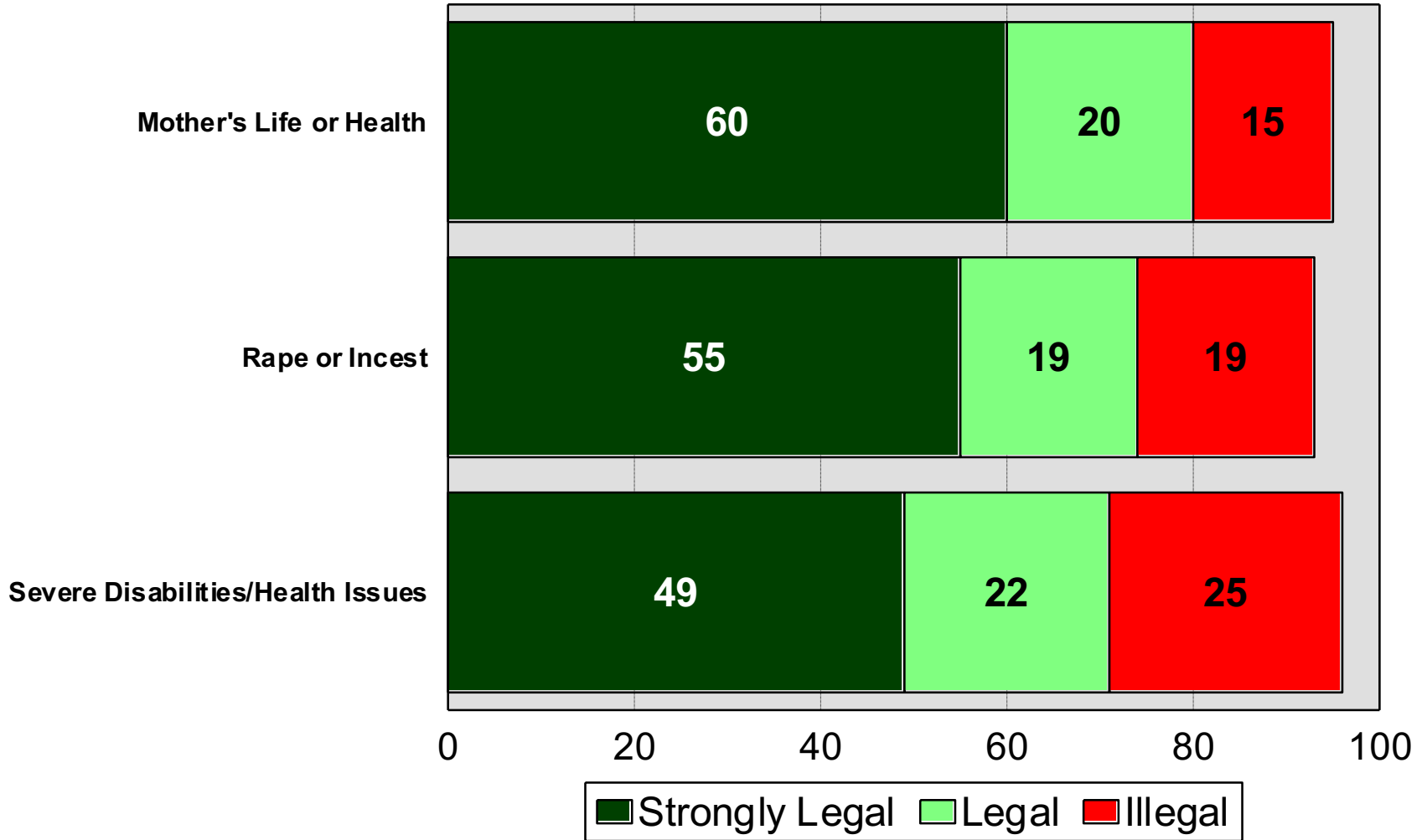

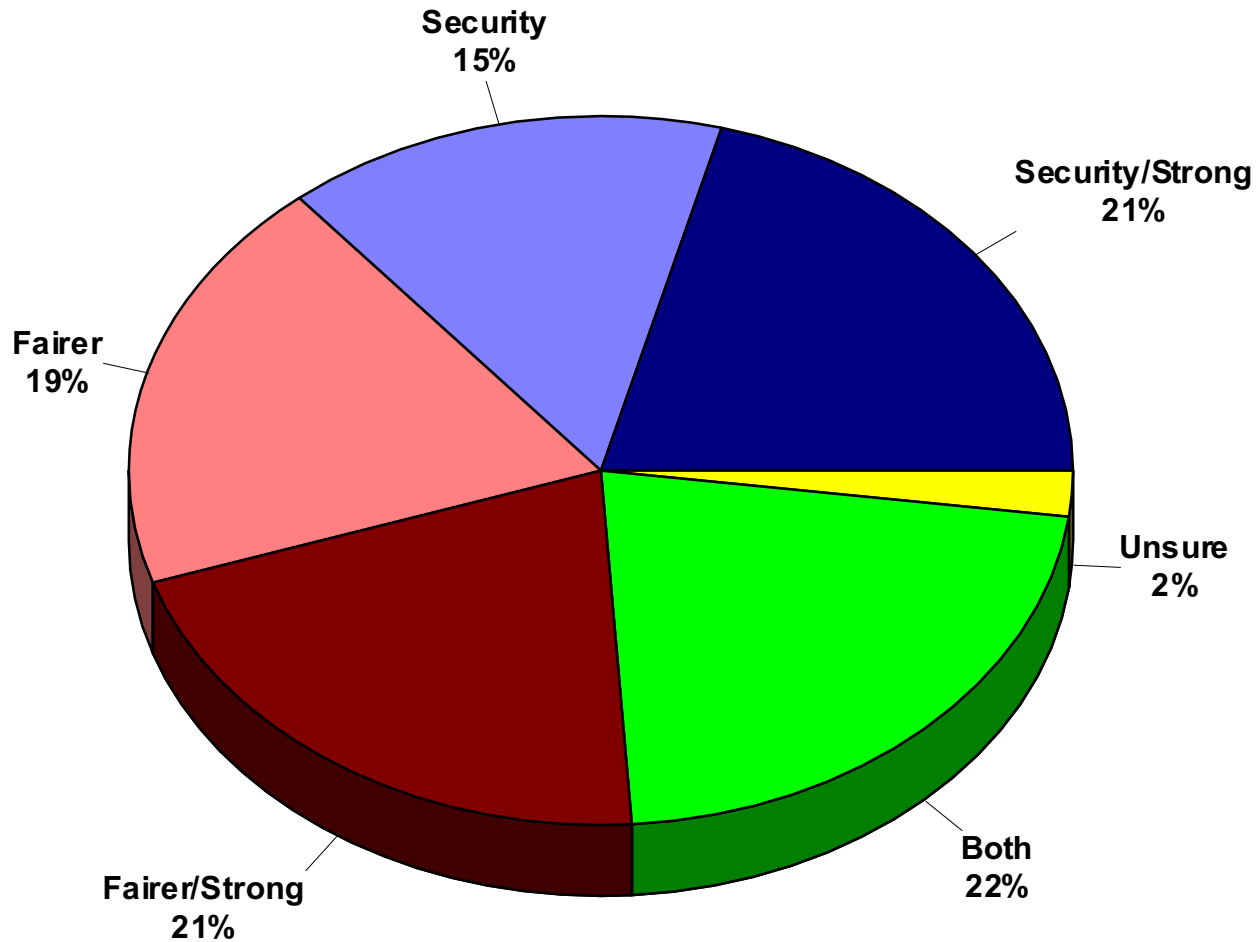

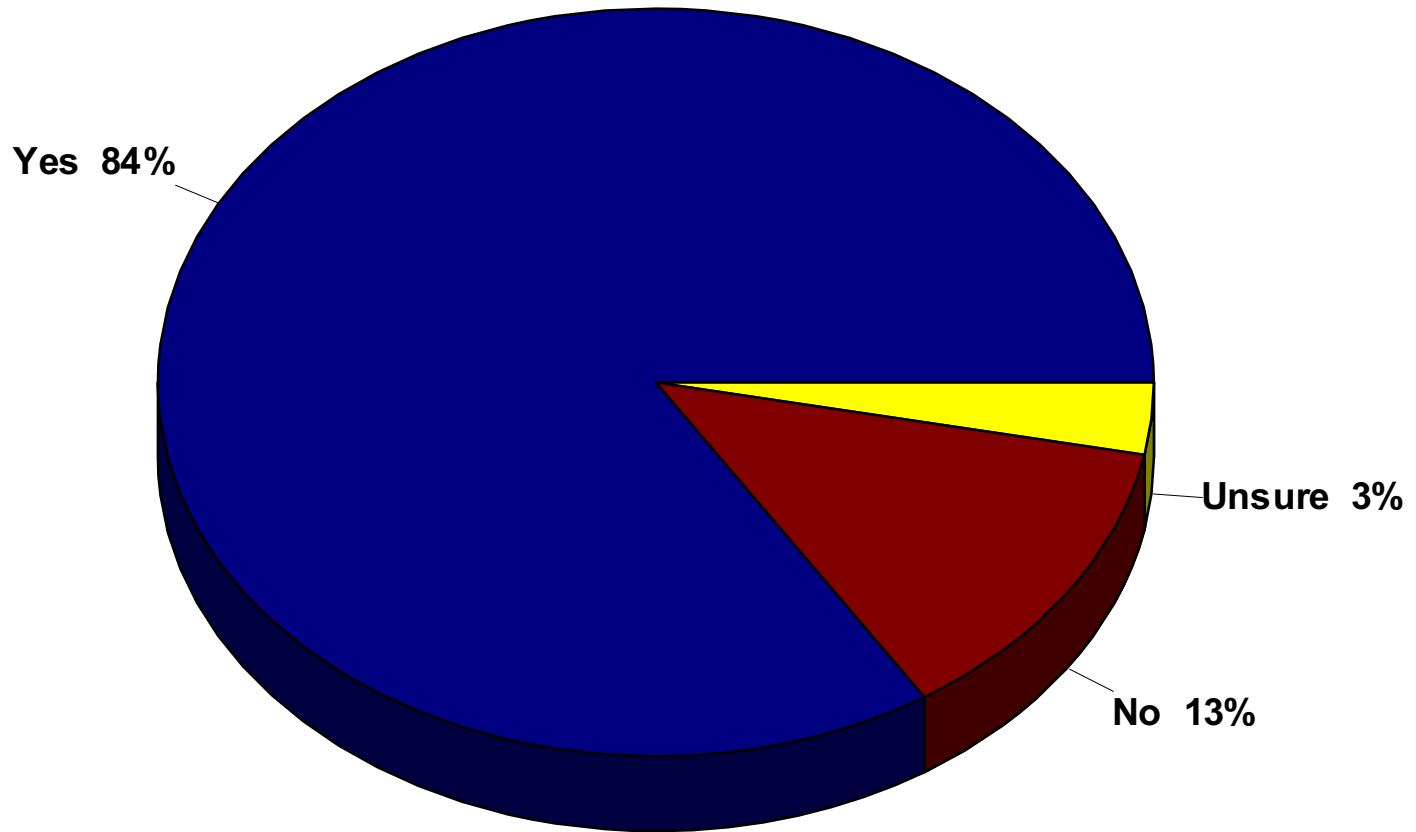

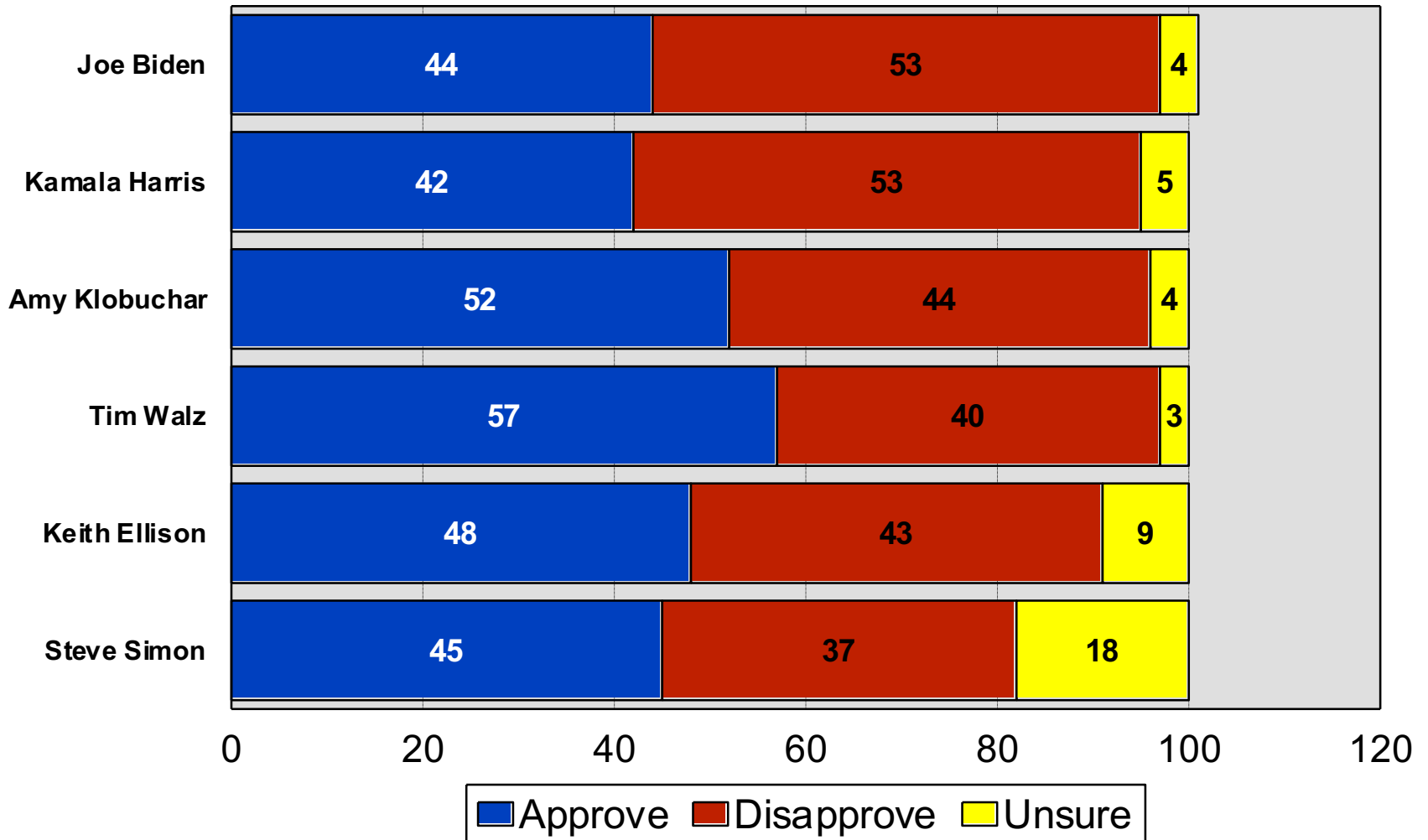

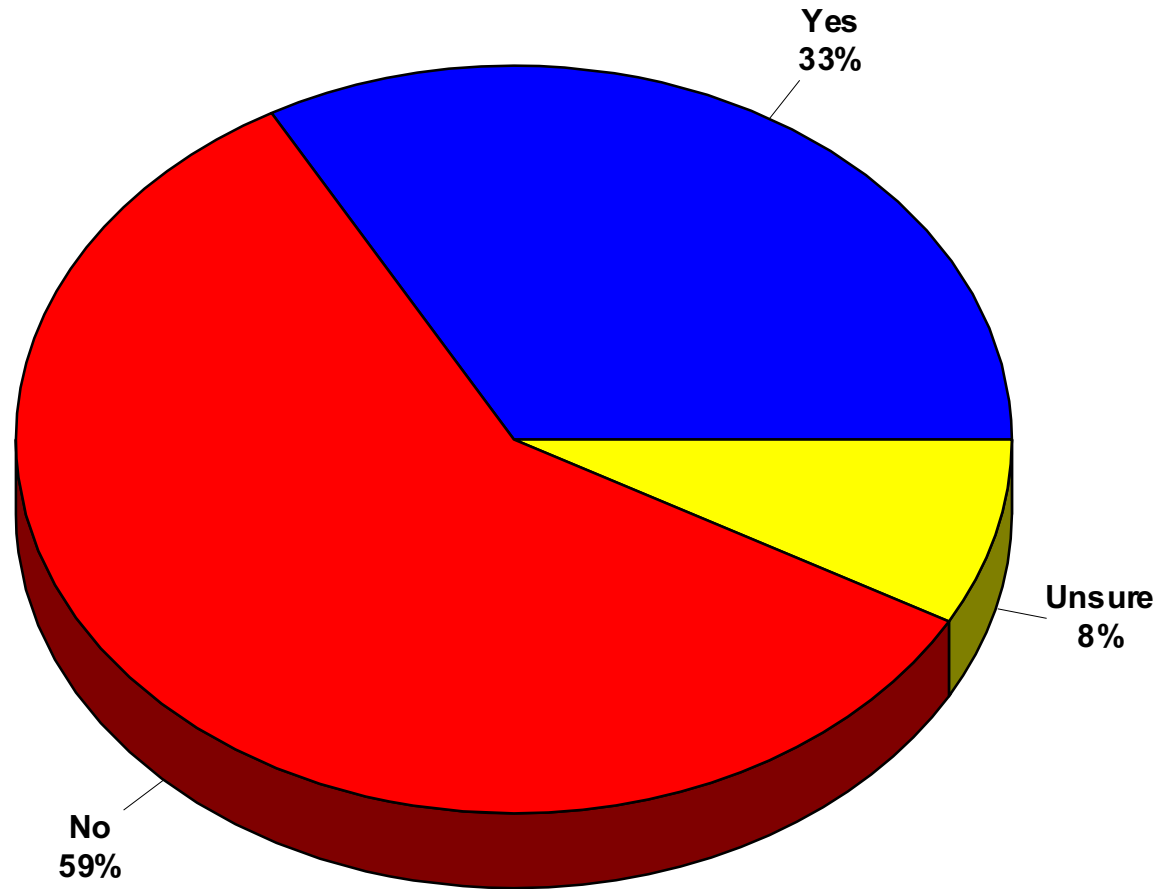

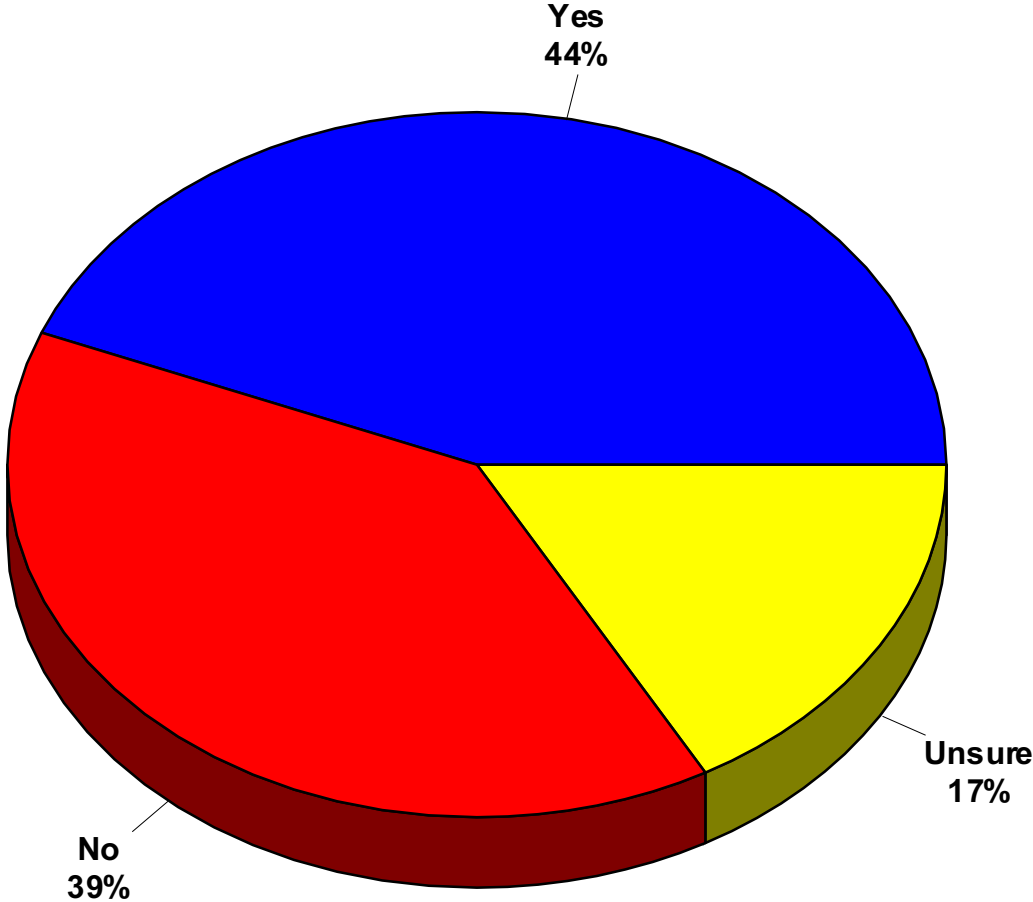

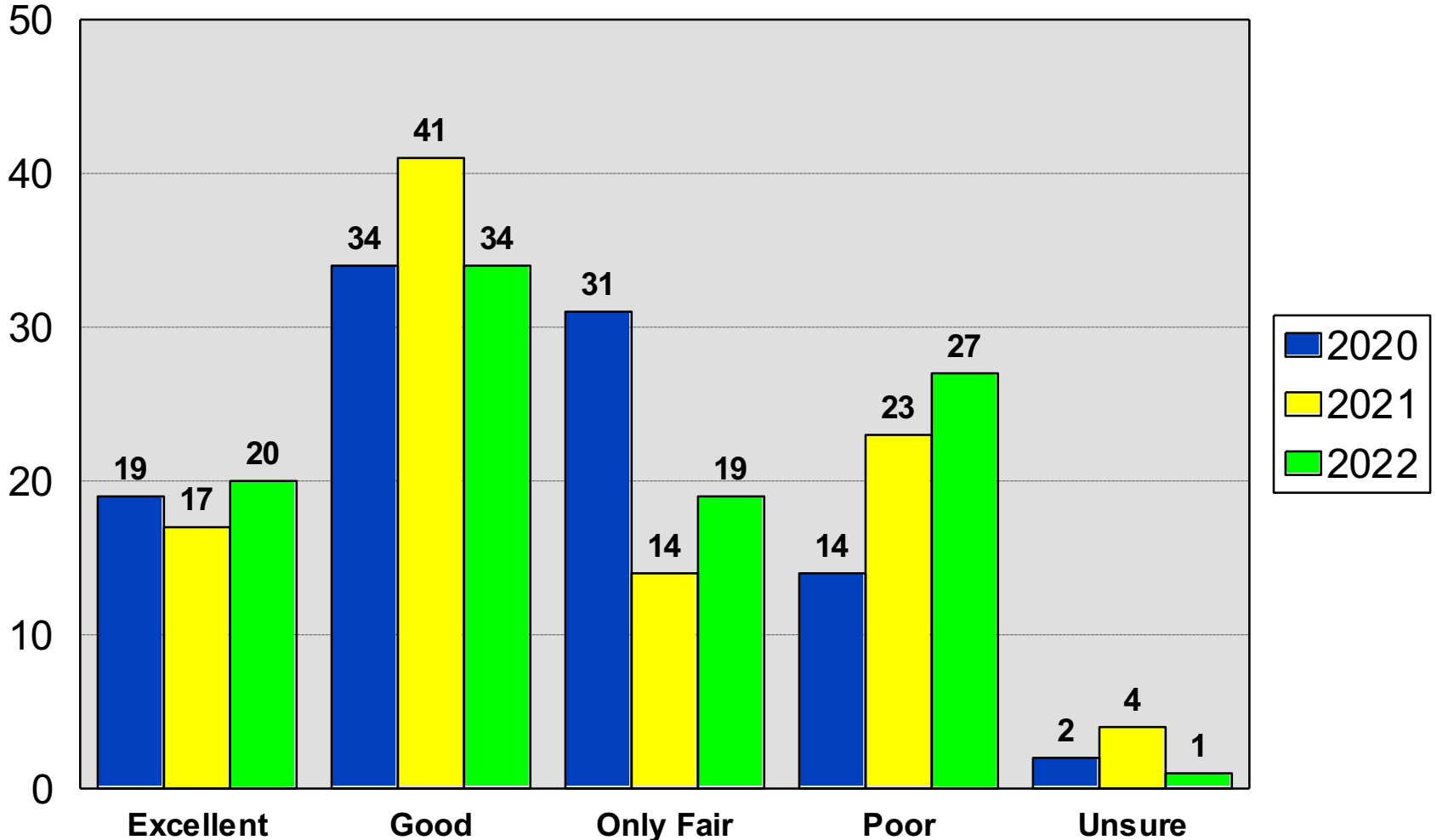

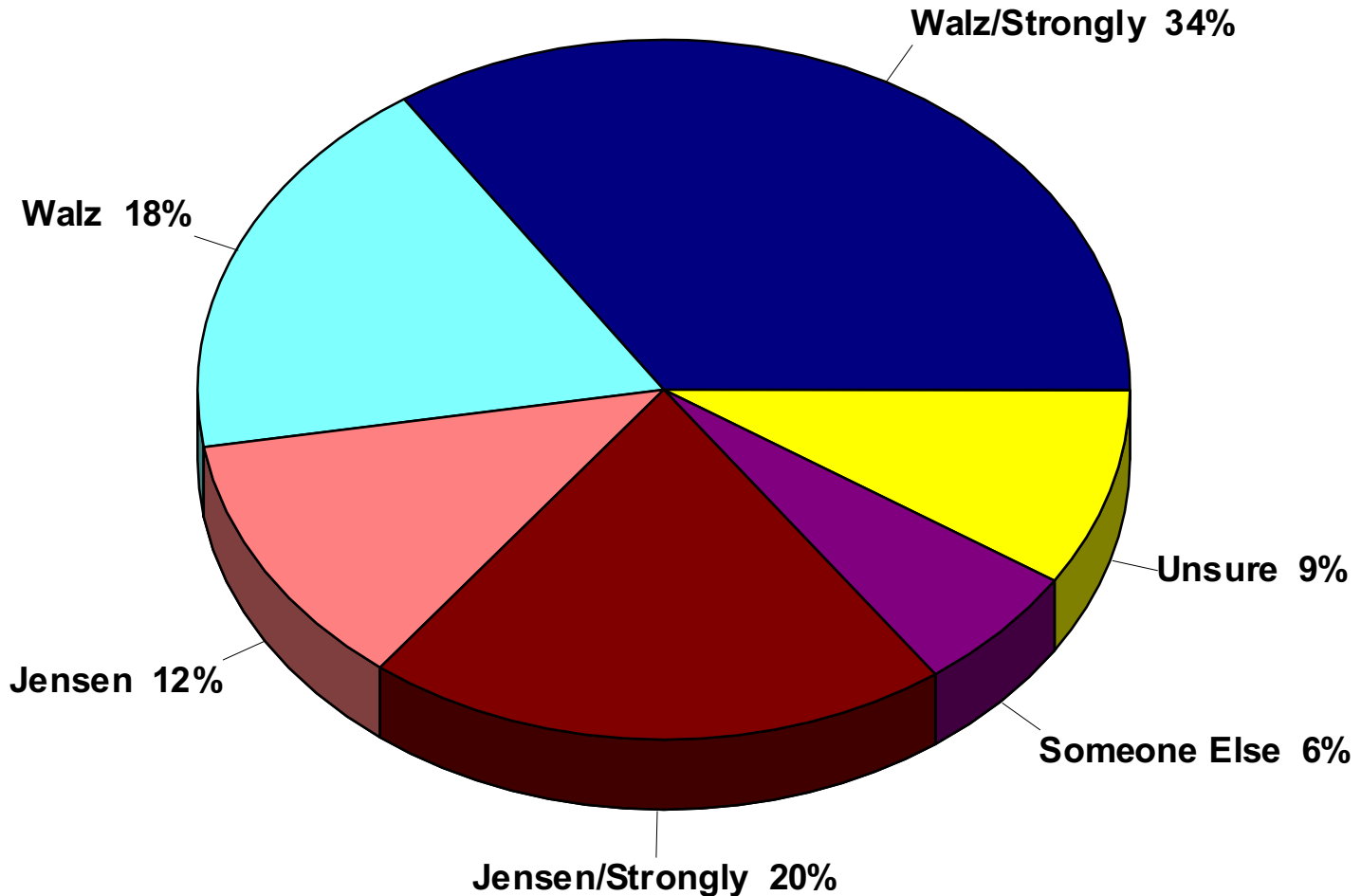

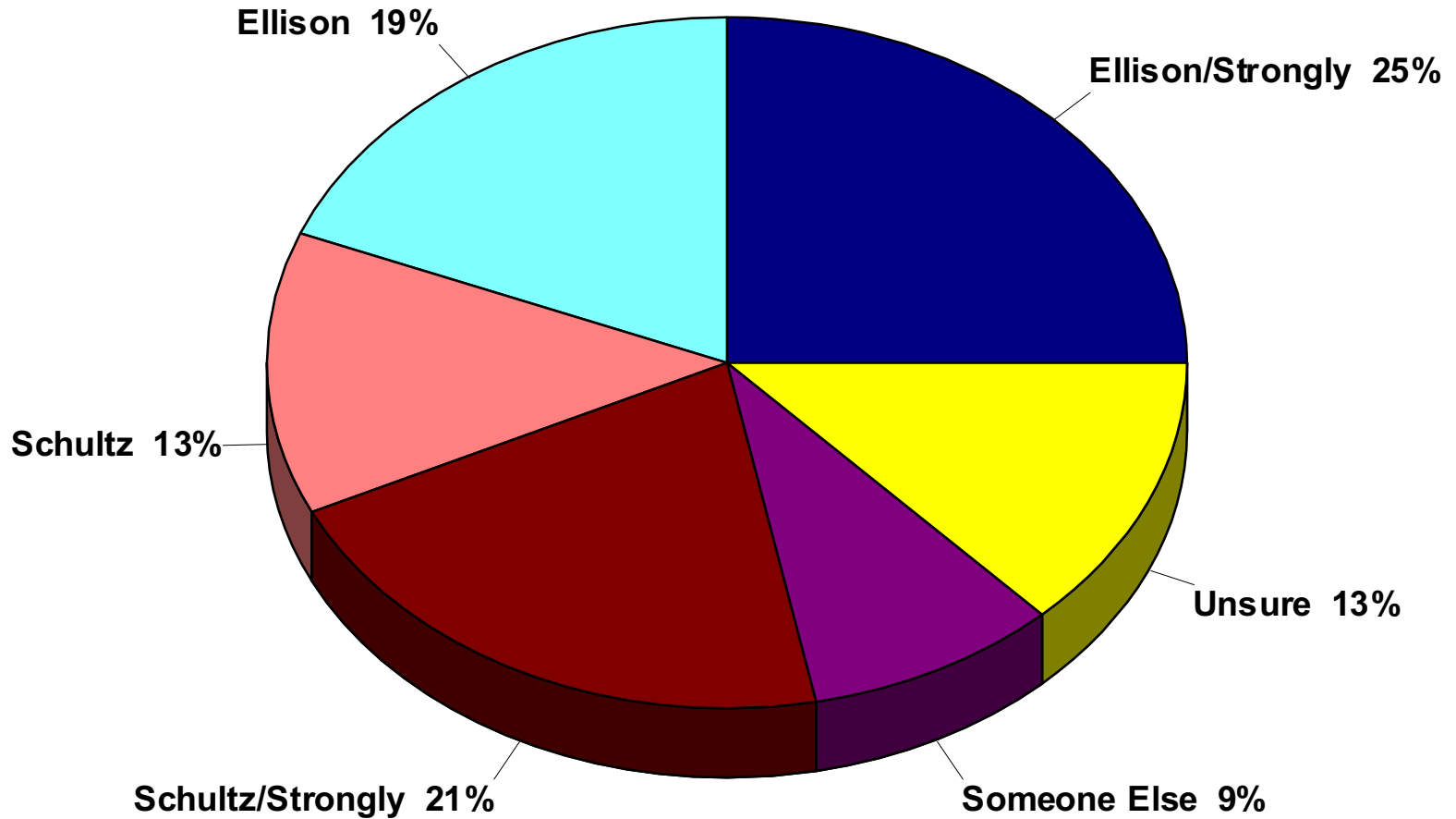

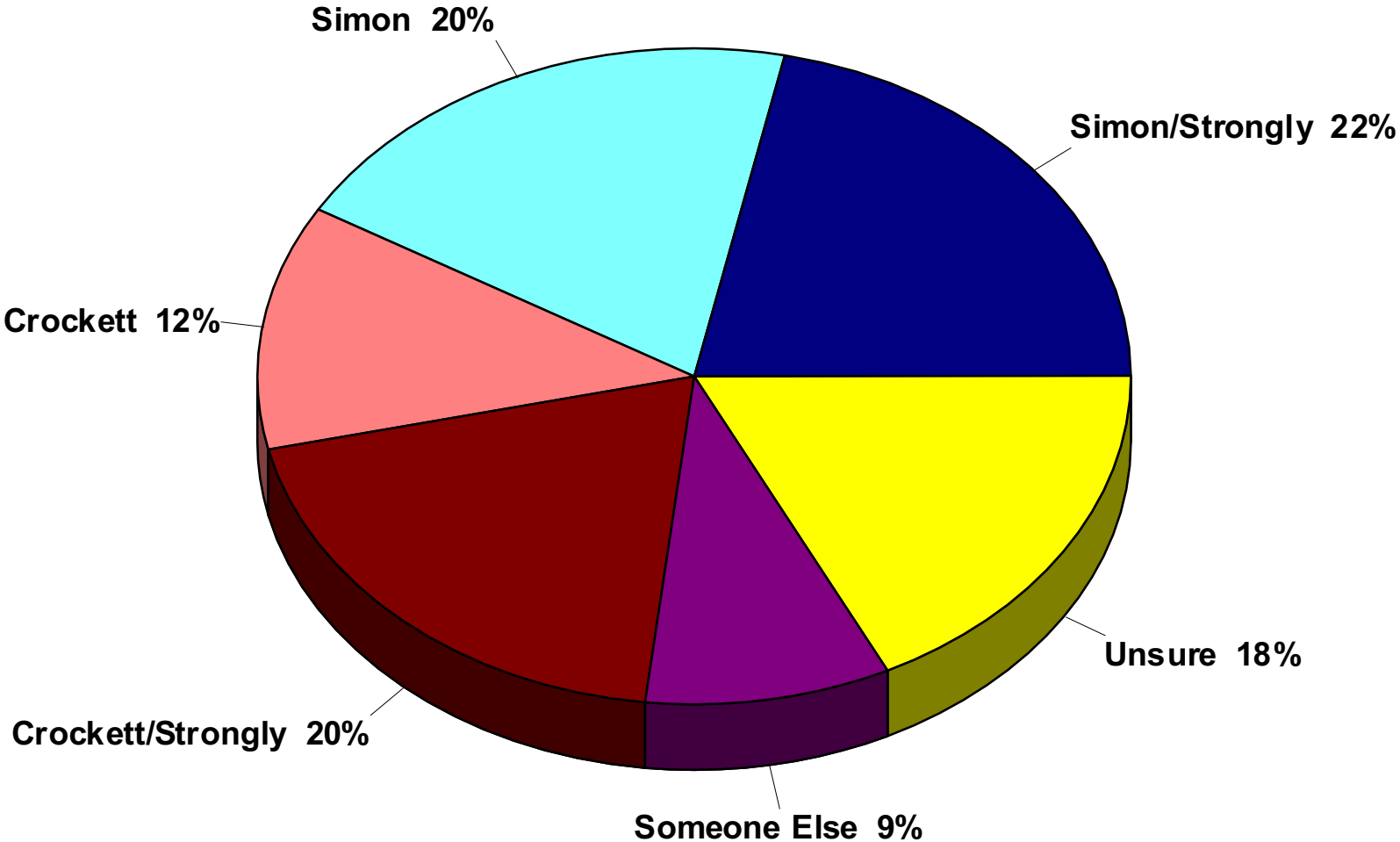

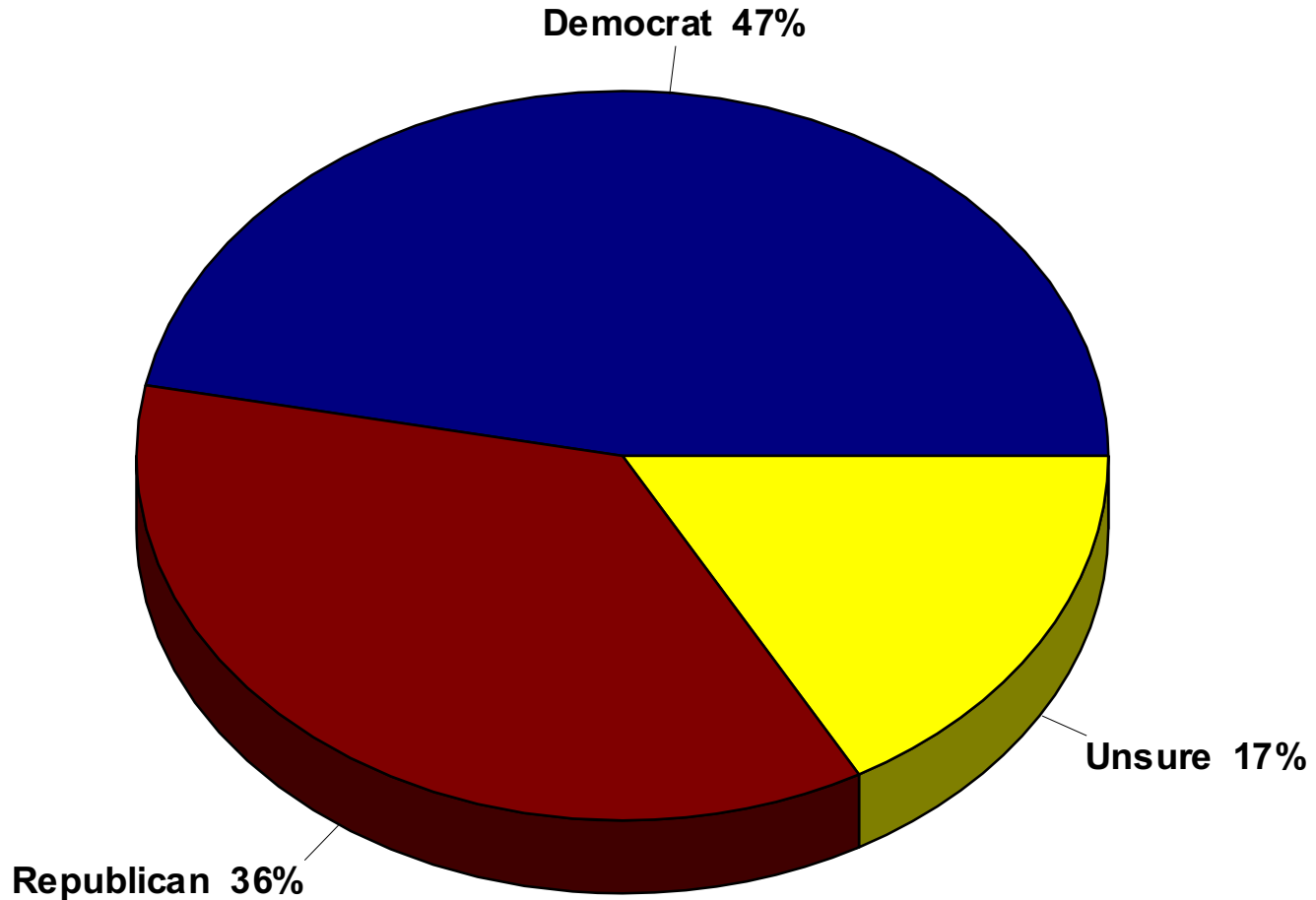
