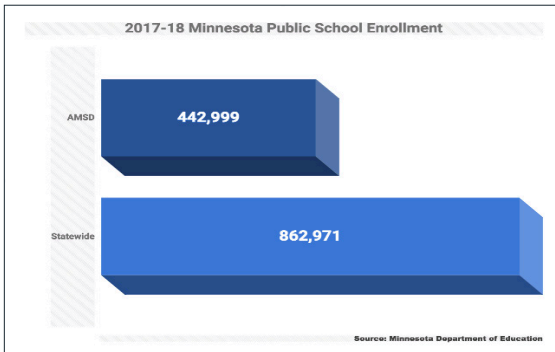




STATE ENROLLMENT

AMSD school districts enroll more than half of all public school students in Minnesota.



STUDENTS OF COLOR

More than 65 percent of the state's nearly 300,000 students of color are enrolled in AMSD school districts. Through its Reimagine Minnesota initiative, AMSD members are committed to closing racial achievement gaps so all students can reach their full potential.

The Association of Metropolitan School Districts has been a strong voice for public education and metro area schools for more than 40 years. AMSD's mission is to advocate for metropolitan school districts and advance legislation that supports student achievement.

AMSD represents 41 K-12 school districts, five intermediate/ educational cooperative districts, and two integration districts, enrolling more than half the state's preK-12 enrollment.

The organization is highly regarded for its nonpartisan research, communication efforts, timely legislative updates, and extensive legislative summaries.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Special Education costs exceeded state and federal education aid by more than \$427 million for AMSD member districts in FY 2017, and more than \$672 million statewide.

ENGLISH LEARNERS

Nearly 70 percent of Minnesota's English learner students attend school in an AMSD member school district. In FY 2017 AMSD districts spent more than \$118 million on services for English learners, but received just \$36 million in English learner funding. In other words, AMSD districts had to redirect nearly \$82 million in general education aid to fund critically important English learner services.

HOMELESS STUDENTS

Nearly 9,000 students in Minnesota are homeless, and more than one half of these students attend a school in an AMSD member district.

FREE AND REDUCED LUNCH

More than 329,000 students in Minnesota qualify for free or reduced lunch prices with approximately 50 percent of those students residing in AMSD member districts.





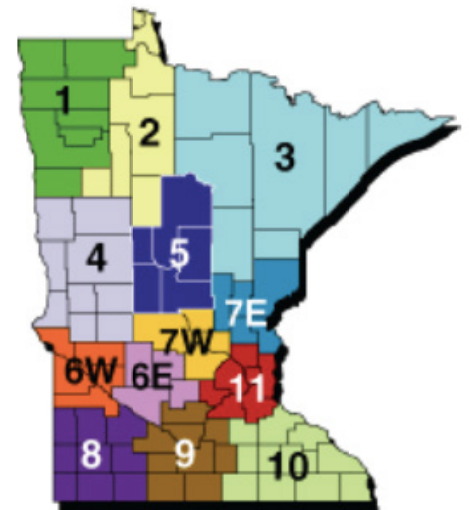

# PERSONNEL COSTS **HIGHER IN AMSD DISTRICTS**

Labor costs, whether in the private or public sector, are significantly higher in the metropolitan area. The average hourly wage in the metro area runs from 10 percent to nearly 30 percent higher than in other regions of the state. The same is true for salaries of teachers and other staff employed by school districts. Minnesota's education funding formula does not recognize this cost differential, making metro school districts reliant on voter-approved operating referenda to cover higher personnel costs.
